In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore Excursions are available on a first-come, first served basis. Guests should note that some shore excursions are very popular with guests and often ending up being waitlisted. In order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com until 48 hours prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate in excursions are subject to availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge Desk within the cancellation deadline. For our selected Shore Excursions Tickets returned after the cancellation deadline will be charged 100% cancellation fee to the guest's onboard account. Cancellation deadlines for the majority of our shore excursions is 48hrs prior to the port of call. Please note that certain shore excursions might have a different cancellation deadline; all cancellation deadlines are stated in the please note section of the shore excursion, booking form and shore excursion tickets.

SHORE EXCURSION SUITABILITY

Silversea offers a broad range of activities for our guests of all physical capabilities. However, certain excursions are more appropriate for physically fit and active guests. All excursions offered are clearly identified with an activity level to assist you. We also offer a good variety of Accesible Shore Excursion worldwide (according to the ports availability and local structure) that are designed for guests unable to negotiate motor coach steps or for full time wheelchair/scooter users. The vehicle used on this type of shore excursion is adapted with an access ramp (or lift where available) to accommodate a limited number of mobility devices. In order to use the ramp and/or lift, guests are required to be seated on a wheelchair or scooter. For your safety and enjoyment and that of your fellow guests, please be certain to select excursions that meet your physical capability. We therefore encourage guests to review the excursion description carefully including the PLEASE NOTE section which includes useful information. Silversea also offers Destination Experience

The Shore Concierge team is available onboard on sea days from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Office opening hours in port may vary whilst staff is shore-side assisting those on excursions. Once onboard, those considering a bespoke excursion should contact the Shore Concierge team at their earliest possible convenience, as time may be a factor in reaching local contacts. Please be aware that once arrangements are confirmed they are non-refundable.

DESTINATION EXPERIENCE BRIEFINGS

Throughout the voyage the Shore Concierge Manager and Destination Consultant will offer port and shore excursion information prior to arrival in each port of call. Their aim is to give you a travel experience that goes beyond the ordinary and answer as many of your questions as possible. The information is presented in the theatre or is pre-recorded and played on your in-suite entertainment system, and will allow more time to enjoy and immerse yourself in each port.

SILVERSEA SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary transportation may be provided by Silversea when the local town is beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists, preventing Silversea from providing a complimentary shuttle. The availability and schedule for this service will be announced onboard and listed in the Silversea Chronicles. We are not able to advise this in advance. Operationally, intervals between shuttle bus departures could be affected by local traffic. Silversea is not liable for any unforeseen delays. There will be a break in service for driver meal times. Shuttle service is offered during the day only. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation; guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

CHILDREN ON TOUR

To ensure the safety of our younger guests, participation by children in certain shore excursions may be restricted. Children up to the age of 8 years old are only permitted to participate in suitable Silver Shore Excursions and the shuttle service if the vehicles are equipped with the correct safety harness and seating equipment. Such harnesses' and secure

seating cannot be guaranteed. Alternately, guests may use their own approved safety seat, booster seat or harness as long as they are compatible with the local touring vehicle and can properly secure the young guest. Silversea reserves the right to refuse children under the age of 8 years old on any tour on the basis of safety.

VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY CHARGES

Please note that photography at some museums, sites and monuments and/or the use of video cameras may not be allowed or may incur a charge. These charges are not included in the tour price and are at guests' own expense. Further details will be in the detailed shore excursion description and please note section. Please ensure to review these in detail prior to departing on your shore excursion.

SHOPPING STOPS

While our organised excursions are not generally geared to the serious shopper, some shore excursions allow for short shopping stops as indicated in the shore excursion description. OPO-A / Oporto & The Douro River

Difficulty



Price: \$129 - Duration: 4.00 hr(s)

Experience one of Europe's oldest cities, dating to the 4th Century when it was an outpost of the Roman Empire. A city rich in history with architectural treasures and home to delicious wines, discover in person its local gothic, baroque and neoclassical flare.

From Leixões port, a 30 -minute panoramic drive along the Douro River side brings you to Ribeira Quarter where you will be boarding your cruise and see Vila Nova de Gaia, where the Oporto Wine cellars are located.

Oporto

Oporto, as it appears today, dates mainly from the 18th century when trade was booming. Merchants built fine houses and financed grand buildings for their city.

Douro River

Following a panoramic drive along the Douro River side head down to the Ribeira Quarter to enjoy a boat ride on the Douro River, providing you with a totally different panorama of Oporto's skyline. On the opposite bank you visit Vila Nova de Gaia, home to the port trade and numerous wine lodges. Here, warehouses continue a tradition dating to the 13th Century with wine produced in the Douro Valley and transported here to mature in giant oak casks. Their brand -name port wines produced here are known worldwide. Visit one of the lodges and learn about the process of wine making before tasting a white & a red Port Wine.

Afterwards, drive back to the port on your coach.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking of approximately 800 meters and several steps to enter the boat and visiting the cellar; it is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or who utilize a wheelchair. We recommend comfortable clothing, walking shoes and sun protection. The order of sites visited on this tour may vary. Due to the distance from the area where the coaches can park and the location of the boats, please be advised that guests will be required to walk approx. 12 minutes on steep cobbled terrain.

OPO-B / Historic Guimaraes

Difficulty



Price: \$99 - Duration: 4.00 hr(s)

The cradle of the nation, Guimarães was the first capital of Portugal and holds a wealth of magnificent buildings and history to discover. Its rich building typology exemplifies the specific development of Portuguese architecture from the 15th to 19th centuries.

Guimarães, King's Castle and Palace of the Dukes of Braganca, Refreshment

Depart the pier by motor-coach for the one-hour journey to Guimarães. Visit the medieval King's Castle and Palace of the Dukes of Braganca (15th century) which houses a museum and art gallery with portraits, tapestries, fine furniture and porcelain. Built from stone down the hill from the castle, the first construction dates from 1420-22, most probably under French influence.

A walking tour through the old city reveals quiet corners and narrow streets, a former manor house situated in the square and a 10th-century church dedicated to the Virgin Mary.

In this historic site you will be treated with a local snack and drink with a brief explication about the typical cakes.

Before you return to the coach to drive back to the port of Leixões, see the Customs Tower emblazoned with the slogan 'Portugal was born here'. After all, this is where the first king, D. Afonso Henriques, lived.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking of approximately 1200 metres on uneven cobble-stoned surfaces and approximately 50 steps. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilize a wheelchair. Comfortable clothing and walking shoes as well as sun protection is recommended.

OPO-E / Douro Valley Wine Tour

Difficulty

Experience the flavours of the first demarcated wine region in the world during this panoramic, full-day excursion to the Douro Valley with lunch.

Leixões, Amarante Village, Guided Stroll, Old Roman Bridge, Churches and Rustic Merchant Shops

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately one-hour drive to charming village of Amarante, hometown to many artists and writers. Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour of the village, cross the old Roman Bridge, and soak up the ambiance of old churches and rustic merchant shops.

Douro Valley, Vineyards, River

Next, re-board your coach and continue on to the Douro Valley, a land of vineyards displayed along terraces of schist framing the river named after its golden-coloured waters, and home to the first demarcated wine region in the world.

Quinta de la Rosa Estate, Visit, Wine Tasting & Lunch

Upon arrival at the Douro Valley, proceed to Quinta de la Rosa Estate, an emblematic winery of the region, for an exclusive port wine experience. Visit the winery and garner a unique insight into the art of making these sweet and powerful wines.

You will have a guided tour of the winery and traditional aging cellar, followed by lunch with a tasting of their wines at the same time: Porto Branco, QLR Branco, QLR Red and an LBV in pairing with dessert. You will be served a set menu selected by the chef and consisting of amuse bouche, main course and dessert.

After lunch, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 2-hour drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately 1.24 miles-1.86 miles (about 2-3 km), at times over uneven, cobblestone and natural surfaces, inclines, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and approximately 60 at the sites visited. This tour is not suitable for guests prone to motion sickness, guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sun protection and a sweater or jacket from the ship. Guests must be at least two years old to participate on this tour. The tour sequence may vary. Space on this tour is extremely limited; we suggest you book well in advance to avoid disappointment.

OPO-F / Tastes of Oporto

Difficulty

Embrace the exquisite flavours of authentic Portuguese cuisine on-foot during this picturesque, half-day food excursion to Oporto.

Leixões, Guided and Narrated Food & Wine Walking Tour

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute drive to Oporto, a coastal city in northwest Portugal known for its stately bridges and port wine production. Upon arrival, begin your guided and narrated food walking tour.

Santa Catarina Street, Markets, *Brasileira* Café, Tastings of Portuguese Cuisine and Port Wine

During your food stroll along Santa Catarina Street, stop at Porto's beloved markets and cafés, including the *Brasileira Café* in Oporto's city centre. Along the way, try 4 regional delights, from sweet custard tarts to savoury classics like a 'bolinho de bacalhau' (codfish). In addition, taste northern Portugal's world-renowned export of port, and learn about its history and cultural impact from your guide. At the conclusion of your food walking tour of Oporto, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately 2.5 miles (about 4 km), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and at the sites visited and cobblestones. Only at *Brasileira Cafe* a glass of wine will be served since guests will be seated. Other food stops will be standing and no drinks are served. This tour is not suitable for guests with food allergies, guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sun protection and a sweater or light jacket and a bottle of water from the ship. Guests must be at least two years old to participate on this tour. The tour sequence may vary. Space on this tour is extremely limited; we suggest you book well in advance to avoid disappointment.

OPO-G / Soul of Oporto: The Ribeira Quarter

Difficulty

Discover Oporto's culture and local tasting on this half-day exploration.

The historic center is of high aesthetic value, with evidence of urban development from the Roman, medieval, and Almadás periods. Board an air-conditioned motor-coach at the pier and travel approximately 30 minutes to the city of Oporto, built along the hillsides overlooking the mouth of the Douro River, an outstanding urban landscape with a 2,000-year history.

Oporto, Stock Exchange Palace

Upon arrival in Oporto, walk along charming pedestrian Oporto Streets towards the Stock Exchange Palace, a pompous 19th-century building with a vast Neoclassical façade is the former stock exchange that was built to impress and earn the credibility of European investors.

Sao Francisco Church, Porto Wine & Local Pastry

Continue to Sao Francisco Church an ordinary 14th century Gothic and Baroque construction, has the most extraordinary church interior in Oporto and unquestionably one of the most fabulously opulent in all Europe.

Finish your visit to Ribeira's quarter, where you can enjoy the fantastic views of the river Douro, with its bridges and typical Rabelo boats while tasting a local pastry accompanied by a glass of the world-renowned Oporto Wine while exploring the Ribeira quarter.

Return to your ship.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking of approximately 2 km over some cobblestone walkways and inclines. A large stairway (25 steps) has to be negotiated to enter and leave the Stock Exchange Palace. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilize a wheelchair. We recommend guests wear comfortable clothing, shoes and bring sun protection. In St. Francisco Church, photos and Videos are not permitted.

Enjoy an amusing walking excursion dedicated to the 'The Pepa' - the signing of the Spanish constitution in the year 1812. Two experienced actors will give you an overview of the history of the signing during a pleasant stroll through the old town of Cadiz.

Old Town

Leaving from the port of Cadiz towards the Plaza España you will find a monument dedicated to the event. During the tour you will meet two 19th Century "characters" in typical Andalusian style dress - Mr. Ramon Power Giralt (a member of the Spanish Parliament) and Lolita Gaditana. In an amusing and distinctive, anecdotal-style these two characters will describe how people lived during this fascinating era.

The stroll continues through streets, gardens and squares, where you will find other places of interest relating to this epoch, including the Church of Carmen, Plaza de San Antonio, Calle Ancha, and the Plaza de San Francisco. Being the oldest town in Western Europe, Cadiz is a great setting for a walking tour steeped in history and making it one of the most important towns of the 17th and 18th centuries.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking for approximately 2 miles over some cobblestone and unpaved surfaces. It is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. We recommend guests wear comfortable clothing, walking shoes and bring sun protection.

XRY-B / Seville!

Experience the splendid beauty and architecture of Seville during a full-day sightseeing excursion to this historic city. Few cities in Spain can rival the charm of Seville. Carmen, Don Giovanni and the Barber of Seville are just a few among the many artistic works that were inspired by this traditional Andalusian town. Founded by Julius Caesar, Seville later became the capital of the Moorish Empire and the highlight of the Spanish Renaissance.

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 75-mile (120-kilometre) drive to Seville, with a comfort stop made en route. Upon arrival, begin with a sightseeing drive through the city then continue with a walking tour through the historic centre.

Seville, Alcazar

During your guided tour of the Mudejar-styled Reales Alcazares, explore its lavish courts, apartments and gardens. Christian kings erected this palace, modelled after the Alhambra in Granada, in the 14th century to replace the original palace built by Moorish rulers in 1181. Continue to Seville's famed landmark, a 270-foot (81-metre) weathervane tower known as 'La Giralda'. The tower is all that remains of a former mosque. From here, proceed to the Seville Cathedral.

Seville Cathedral

Construction on this magnificent Cathedral started in the early 1400s, and took more than a century to complete. The interior of the Cathedral features splendid works of art, and contains the tombs of the Spanish monarchs and Christopher Columbus. Leaving the Cathedral, proceed for a visit to Seville's Old Jewish Quarter.

Old Quarter

King Fernando III forced Jews to live in this former ghetto, known as 'Barrio de Santa Cruz'. Whitewashed houses line narrow, winding alleys and the walls of picturesque courtyards burst with brilliant flowers. Today, many of the buildings house souvenir shops, art galleries and cafés.

Next, you have approximately 1.5 hours leisure time for shopping and lunch on your own at one of the area's many restaurants before re-boarding your coach for a drive exiting Seville. After passing by Plaza America, a photo stop is made at the Plaza de España, a monumental square built for the 1929 World's Fair Plaza, before returning to the pier.

XRY-H / Scenic Cádiz & Flamenco

In the early 16th century, Cádiz served as a launching point for the journey to the newly discovered lands of America. Later raided by Sir Francis Drake, in the struggle to gain control of trade with the New World, the city managed to withstand a siege by Napoleon's army. In the early 19th century it became the bastion of Spain's anti-monarchist, liberal movement, as a result of which the country's first Constitution was declared here in 1812. Some of the city's 18th century walls still stand and the old, central quarter is famous for its picturesque charm.

Depart the port area on your motor coach for an approximate 1-hour panoramic drive through the city.

Old Town

The old city looks quite Moorish in appearance and is intriguing with narrow cobbled streets opening onto small squares where the golden cupola of the cathedral looms high above long white houses. Get to know the Parque Genoves, one of the major areas of greenery of the town. Between the Parque Genoves and the attractive Caleta Beach you will find the Castillo of Santa Catalina, which is formed by the remains of the old canal that once crossed Cádiz. Pass by the 18th Century Baroque and neo-classical Cathedral. It has a dome of yellow tiles, which forms the chief landmark of the city. See also the old tobacco factory and the Town Hall in the Plaza de San Juan de Dios.

Exit the bus at the Plaza de España, where you will see a fine monument to the first Spanish constitution of 1812.

Flamenco Performance

After a short walk you arrive at the flamenco tavern "La Cava", the setting for tapas and an authentic flamenco performance. This is a traditional tavern with a distinctive flamenco feel to its decoration and furnishings; the design is in wood, glass and wrought iron. Flamenco is the music of Spanish gypsies, influenced by both Western and Moorish sources. Sit back and drink in a traditional performance of its staccato, balletic dances, its haunting ballads and its fiery guitar music.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking to and from the bus with some inclines. This tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair being able to negotiate bus steps. We recommend guests wear comfortable clothing, walking shoes and bring sun protection.

Cádiz is the Iberian Peninsula's oldest continuously-inhabited city and lies on a narrow spit of land, surrounded by the Mediterranean Sea.

Walking Tour, Plaza de España, 19th-century Palaces, Cathedral

This comprehensive program is entirely on foot from the pier.

Your guided stroll begins at Plaza de España, near the port. As with most other Cádiz squares, the nearby Plaza de la Mina, was formerly a large vegetable garden belonging to the San Francisco Convent. You will stroll past the exterior of the Museum, which contains three sections, including an important archaeological exhibit.

While strolling Calle Ancha (Wide Street), you will view several handsome 19th-century Palaces. Nearby, San Juan de Dios Square is protected by seawalls and features a unique marble fountain. But perhaps the Town Hall is the building that best reflects the grace and style of the city.

After a 40-minute visit to the interior of the impressive Cádiz Cathedral, you may either walk back to the pier or remain in town to continue exploring at your leisure.

Please Note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking of approximately 3 km (2 miles) and is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Depart from Cadiz and enjoy a 75-minute motorcoach ride to the peaceful Pueblo Blanco of Arcos de la Frontera, perched high in the hilltops of the Cadiz Sierras.

Arcos de la Frontera, Gothic Cathedral

These white villages date back to the Spaniard's centuries-long fight to win Spain back from the Muslims (Moors). Arcos' name, de la Frontera, reflects this frontier history. While the wars began in the 9th century, Spain wasn't secure until the 15th century. Yet the town itself became a pillar of Christianity after Alfonso the Wise of Castile (1252-1284) expelled the Moors. The Gothic Cathedral he built remains on its high ridge and is known for its ten bells, which tolled throughout the war with the Moors. Several Moorish banners were taken in the nearby battle of Zahara and have been on display in a church in Arcos since 1483.

Old city walking exploration

Once you arrive, commence your an hour-long walking tour of this cliff-side town. Explore the labyrinth of narrow streets and alleys that run out from the Plaza Cabildo. Along the way, admire several churches that were built during the 15th and 16th centuries. Be sure to notice the old Castillo and Santa Maria Church that overlook the square. Strolling through town, come across the impressive homes of nobility, sporting large arched and carved doorways, intermingled with the modest homes of merchants and craftspeople.

Parador, Casa del Corregidor, breath-taking panoramic views and local tapas

Proceed to the old part of the city and the Parador, a former palace that nowadays is a luxurious hotel, and the Casa del Corregidor, the 14th century home of the king's magistrate. Relish the breath-taking panoramic views of the Guadalete River and the plains and farms beyond. Enjoy some tapas and local refreshments. Afterwards, return to your motorcoach for the ride back to Cadiz and re-board the ship.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking for approximately 2 miles over some cobblestone and steep surfaces with a few steps to negotiate to access the bus and the old city. Cadiz & scenic drive to Jerez de la Frontera

Comfortably from your bus, admire the landscape that changes from dry lands of the coast line to the fertile cultivated ones nearby Jerez.

Cellars of Bodegas Osborne, Sherry Tasting & Local Tapas

Next, visit the cellars or bodegas as they are called in Puerto de Santa Maria . During this guided tour through the wine cellar Bodegas Osborne. Visit the historic wineries and learn firsthand about the winemaking process behind our estate's greatest treasures. Taste the finest wines, find out about the traditional production of our Iberian pork products and enjoy the visit in Osborne's most emblematic cellars.

Walk through the labyrinthic corridors formed by aging-wine barrels. Some of those barrels, called "bota" are over 200 years old and are not on sale as they have an emotional meaning for the company. You will have the unique opportunity to taste wines and appetizers such as the best-awarded ham in

the world Jamon 5J and Caña de Lomo 5J (loin cane), served in the room where the Osborne Family still meets today. At the end of the visit, you will have the opportunity to buy local products of Osborne. Enjoy these specialties accompanied in the background by a flamenco guitar player.

After approx. 35 minutes by coach or van, you will arrive at Sanlúcar de Barrameda, a charming coastal village in the extreme southwest corner of Spain with an outsized culinary & cultural heritage. Its seafood is prized throughout Spain, earning the village the official title of Gastronomic Capital of Spain in 2022.

Hidalgo vineyard, drive to Bodegas Hidalgo

Your first stop is the Hidalgo vineyard, where expansive views of limestone vineyards drop into the Atlantic Ocean. Here you'll appreciate first hand how the salty air of the Atlantic, along with the unique characteristics of the chalky albariza terroir, come together to favor the growth and flavor profile of the palomino grape, as well as appreciate the geography which enabled sherry's spread throughout the world since it's down the road where Columbus and Magellan set sail to the New World more than 500 year ago.

After approx. 15 minutes drive, you arrive at the historic center of Sanlúcar de Barrameda at the Bodegas Hidalgo. Family run by the 8th generation, the bodega is a living testament to Sanlúcar's centuries-old relationship to the sea, to cuisine and to sherry making.

Bodegas Hidalgo

With an aging and cupage technique known as solera and proximity to the salty sea air of the Atlantic Ocean, sherry winemaking is a universe unto itself, Gain a first-hand understanding of the terroir, the palomino grape and the complexity of the sherry making practice, perfected over the centuries. Explanations and barrel tastings of 40-60-year-old rare oloroso, amontillado and palo cortado sherries are among the most exclusive tasting experiences in this region of Spain. With family heirlooms and old accounting books spanning centuries and continents, the fascinating story of the Hidalgo family is brought to life. Sherry explanations are paired with traditional tapas before entering the grand salon for a seated gourmet lunch among thousands of barrels in the bodega's grand salon.

Your Hosts: Victor & Carlos

Local expert and native Andalusian, Carlos will greet S.A.L.T. guests directly in the port of Cádiz and accompany them to our first stop, the vineyard belonging to the winery. Here we'll be joined by Victor, a native of Sanlúcar de Barrameda. Both Carlos and Victor are a wealth of knowledge, with colorful anecdote and personal narrative celebrating the culture of sherry making and the culinary traditions of their native Cádiz province. Following your meal, return to your coach or van for the ride back to Cadiz and re-board the ship.

AGP-A / Málaga Highlights

Difficulty

Explore the splendid landmarks, attractions and architecture of the capital of the Costa del Sol during this scenic, half-day visit to Málaga, a historic and culturally rich provincial capital which has long lived in the shadow of the iconic Andalusian cities of Granada, Córdoba and Seville. Yet, it has rapidly emerged as the province's city of culture with its so-called 'mile of art' being compared to Madrid, and its dynamism and fine dining to Barcelona.

Depart the pier for the approximate 30-minute sightseeing drive along Alameda Boulevard en route to the hilltop location of Gibralfaro.

Gibralfaro

As you walk along the ramparts crowning the 560-foot (168-metre) summit, take in splendid views over the city, the harbour and the bullring. Afterward, re-board the coach for the drive back down to the city centre.

Alcazaba

From City Hall, take a brief walk to the Alcazaba. At the foot of this ancient fortress, view the excavated ruins of a Roman amphitheatre. The restored Alcazaba dates back to the 11th century, when the king of Granada ordered the fortress built and modelled on the style of the Alhambra. After the Christian conquest, the Catholic kings took over the Alcazaba, and King Philip IV used it as his Málaga residence. Leaving the Alcazaba, your walk continues on to the cathedral.

Cathedral

The cathedral's splendid interior is highlighted by exquisitely-carved choir stalls, and other fine examples of Spanish Renaissance sculpture.

Following your visit, some free time is made available to explore the surrounding area before re-boarding your coach for the drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking, with stairs to negotiate at Gibralfaro and Alcazaba. Total distance on foot is approximately 3 km (2 miles). It is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. The order of sites visited may vary. Discover the beauty and charm of a typical Andalusian village during this scenic visit to Mijas. Mijas is both a charming traditional mountain village and sophisticated, cosmopolitan city. The village emerges amidst evergreen pine trees, inviting you to explore its nooks and crannies and photograph the famous donkey "taxis".

Depart the pier for the scenic, one-hour drive from Málaga to Mijas. En route, proceed along Málaga's main avenue, which is lined by the City Hall, the old Customs Building and the main Post Office. Next, head out of Málaga and follow the Costa del Sol road, passing through the resorts of Torremolinos and Benalmadena. At Fuengirola, your drive turns inland and follows the winding road up to Mijas. Upon arrival, leave the coach in the parking area and explore the city centre on-foot.

Mijas

Gleaming white houses greet your arrival in this picturesque village situated at an altitude of 1,280 feet (384 metres). Many of the buildings in Mijas are decorated with iron grilles and brilliant flowers spilling over the walls. Its superb location and typical Andalusian ambience make Mijas a popular tourist spot.

Your guided tour begins with a walk through the narrow cobblestone streets before enjoying free time to explore the area at your leisure, or browse the Andalusian crafts found in the market centre. Another option is a ride on the Mijas donkey-taxi (be sure to establish the fare before starting out).

Following your visit, re-board your coach for the one-hour return drive to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking some of which is over cobbled surfaces, with some steps to climb. Total distance covered is approximately 1.600 m (1 mile). AGP-D / Picasso & Old Málaga

Málaga is not only the capital of the Costa del Sol, but also a cultural reference on a national and international level. Since opening in 2003, the Picasso museum has surpassed the most optimistic forecasts, enabling visitors to enjoy over two hundred major works by an artist considered to be the towering genius of 20th-century world painting.

Málaga

Depart the pier towards the city of Málaga, one of the oldest cities in the world, founded in the 8th century founded by the Phoenicians. Your first stop is Calle Larios, the main shopping street of Málaga.

Next, cross Constitution Square, then walk along Calle Granada to the Plaza de la Merced. Here, discover Picasso's birthplace and an exhibition about the famous artist, then proceed to the highlight of the tour, the Picasso Museum of Málaga, or 'Museo Picasso Málaga'.

Picasso Museum

The Picasso Museum is permanently housed in the Palacio de Buenavista, a 16th-century historical building that is adorned with the Andalusian architecture of the day, along with a unique blend of Renaissance and Mudejar elements. Museo Picasso Málaga was created in response to Pablo Picasso's own desire for his work to be present in the city where he was born on October 25, 1881. VAL-A / Valencia Past & Present

Spain's third-largest city is a magnificent place, content for Madrid and Barcelona to grab the headlines while it gets on with being a wonderfully live-able city with a thriving cultural. Never afraid to innovate, Valencia diverted its flood-prone river to the outskirts of town and converted the former riverbed into a wonderful green ribbon of park winding right through the city.

Depart the pier and enjoy a panoramic drive along the Avenida del Puerto to the Gran Via and Calle Jativa, past the Bullring and Central Station. See the Central Market, an enormous metal, ceramic tile and glass Art Nouveau building built in 1928, with its 1300 stalls of fresh fish, meat and fruits and other products from all over Spain.

La Lonja

Your walking tour begins at La Lonja, or The Silk Exchange, the main monument of the city and considered to be one of Europe's most beautiful examples of Gothic civil architecture. Built between 1482 and 1533, during Valencia's golden age, the building illustrates the power and wealth of one of the great Mediterranean mercantile cities. The building was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1996.

City of Arts & Sciences

Designed by Santiago Calatrava and Félix Candela, this unique complex is devoted to science, technology, nature and house in five buildings: El Palau de les Arts Reina Sofia - opera house and performing arts centre; L'Hemisfèric - Imax Cinema, Planetarium and Laserium; L'Umbracle - a walkway and garden; El Museu de les Ciències Príncipe Felipe - a science museum; L'Oceanogràfic - an open-air oceanographic park; Àgora - a versatile space that can stage conventions, concerts and performances.

Enjoy a guided interior visit of the Palau de les Arts Reina Sofia, considered the highlight of the City of Arts & Sciences.

Palau de les Arts Reina Sofia

With its impressive architecture, this spectacular building is dedicated to promoting the performing arts. It is an impressive theatre and opera house, with four venues for opera, music, ballet & theatre.

Your walking tour concludes at the coach that will return you to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking for approximately 4 km in the city centre and at the Oceanographic Park where, in case elevators are not in service approximately 150 steps are to be negotiated. It is not suitable for guests utilising a wheelchair or those with limited mobility. We recommend wearing comfortable clothing, walking shoes and sun protection. VAL-B / Valencia by Bike

Discover Valencia's old quarter in a unique way during this scenic half-day bicycle excursion. There are few cities like Valencia, able to harmoniously combine the remnants of its farthest past, dating to the year 138 BC, with the most innovative and avant-garde buildings from the new millennium.

Depart the pier via coach for a short panoramic drive through Valencia, Spain's third most important city. Valencia is known as the Flower City because of its vast number of parks and landscaped areas. Be introduced to your guide and then fitted with your bike and briefed with safety instructions. The city is virtually flat which makes viewing so enjoyable by bicycle.

Follow your guide as you slowly make your way to the City of the Arts and Science, later on you will head to the historical city center. The stops will be the following:

City of Arts and Science

This architectural complex comprises the very Museum of Arts and Science, the Hemisphere, Palau Reina Sofía, "el ágora", the Oceanographic and the cosy "Umbracle Gardens".

Serrano Towers

The Serrano Towers mark the entrance to the old walls of Valencia City. They are considered one of the best-preserved monuments in Valencia.

Tapas

We will have a temporary rest at Alameda's promenade for little tapas and a drink.

Central Market

Make your way to the market which is considered one of the oldest European markets in operation and located directly in the La Lonja area.

Miguelete Tower and Cathedral

Continue your ride and view one of the city's most emblematic monuments located beside the main door of the Cathedral and next to the Provincial Palace and the Torres de Serrano. The Miguelete Tower, from the top, offers outstanding views over Valencia and its fertile agricultural area.

Plaza de la Virgen

Ride by what was once the main square of Valencia, the Plaza de la Virgen, one of the prettiest of the many plazas in Valencia.

Rejoin your awaiting coach and drive back to the port and terminal building.

Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of bicycling for approximately 2.5 hours and approximately 10km (6.2 miles). This tour is recommended for guests who are in good physical condition, and experienced and confident bicycle-riders as the ride goes over and through uneven terrain, crowded areas and streets with motorized vehicles. Upon arrival, board a the trolley train or minibus for a picturesque ride through the town centre. Along the way, your guide points out sites of interest and their place in the town's history. From here, continue up the hill leading to the Xátiva Castle. Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour through this historic castle and its Museum of the Borgias, Gates of Hannibal and Battery.

Old Town, La Seu Cathedral (outside visit only), Way of Saint James, Almuddin

Following your castle tour, re-board the Trolley train or minibus for the ride back to the old town. Upon arrival, take a guided stroll through the Old City of Xativa, and pass by notable landmarks that include La Seu Cathedral (outside visit only), the Way of Saint James and Almuddin.

Montserrat Restaurant, City of Arts and Sciences

Experience the rich history of Requena and its winemaking traditions during this picturesque, half-day sightseeing excursion and wine tasting. Requena was born during the Iberian age. Romans were here too, but the Arabs were who gave the name to the town, originally named "Rakana", the strong, the self-confident. Later called Requena, it has become one of the biggest towns of the province of Valencia and has an area specially dedicated to vineyards and wine production with "denominacion de origen" D.O., meaning a prestigious product classification which is awarded to products that are produced in designated Spanish regions according to stringent production criteria. D.O.

Pago de Tharsys Winery

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximate one-hour drive to historic Requena, an area specially-dedicated to vineyards and wine production, for a visit to the Pago de Tharsys Winery. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of the winery and explore its culture of wines and cava. Founded in 1808, the original winery has a beautiful setting where you are invited to a wine tasting accompanied by local 'embutidos' consisting of Spanish salami and cured ham. You can also browse the fine selection of wines and cava for sale.

Requena

Next, re-board your coach and drive to the Old Quarter of Requena. During your visit, take a guided stroll through the small town quarter of La Villa. Along the way, see a collection of historic buildings situated in a walled Muslim area known as the Alcazaba, Medina or Arrabales.

Underground Cellar and Caves

Your final stop is a visit to the region's oldest cellar. Situated in underground caves beneath the Old Quarter, it was used as a shelter, wine cellar and even as a silo. A guided tour of this cellar offers a unique insight into the rich history of Requena.

Afterward, re-board your coach and commence the approximate 75-minute drive back to the pier.

Valencia, College of High Silk Art, Museum

Depart the pier for the short drive to the College of High Silk Art, which is located in the old seat of the Higher Art of Silk-Making Authority, an institution established in 1477 to set rules and standards of quality for Valencian silk-makers. During your guided visit to this 15th-century building, renovated in the 18th century, stop by the Museum to learn out about the history of silk in Valencia, hand-made process of weaving and rich artistic heritage of the building itself. In addition, your guide describes the arduous preparation of the Espolin characteristics of Valencian clothing.

After the museum visit, the guests will have possibility to visit traditional silk shop located in the museum. The Valencia Silk Museum store offer exclusive artisanal items made from natural Valencian silk.

Barri de Velluters, Central Market, Tasting of Horchata & Farton

Next, take a short stroll through the Barri de Velluters, a neighbourhood established by velvet-makers in 1465. Your walking tour continues with a stop to the bustling Central Market where you can enjoy a short free time to stroll around it. This early-20th-century building spans over 26,000 square feet (about 2,415 square metres), and hosts 400 stalls specialising in fresh products. During your walking tour, stop for a tasting of 'horchata', a typically sweet and refreshing drink made from tiger nuts, and 'fartons'.

Silk Exchange Building

Your last stop is at the cornerstone of UNESCO's Silk Road Project, the Silk Exchange building. A masterpiece of Mediterranean civil Gothic architecture, this building is the only UNESCO World Heritage Site in Valencia. The Silk Exchange was built between 1483-1548 to facilitate trade between the producers of the rich silk fabrics made in Valencia, and the merchants their silk products attracted from all over Europe. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves moderate amount of walking for approximately 2.5 km, at times over uneven, cobblestone and natural surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and at the approximate 65 steps at the sites visited; lifts are available, except at the Silk Market. Guests must consider approximately 3 hours walking. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes. Guests must be at least 21 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. Valencia, Algirós Market

Depart the pier for the panoramic drive to Algirós, a relatively new district of Valencia located along the old road connecting the city and village of Cabanyal, for a visit to the Algirós Market. Upon arrival, meet your chef and take a guided stroll through the local market. See various bakeries offering fresh bread, pastries, sweets, cookies, assorted baked goods, a wide variety of cheeses and deli goods, an herbal corner with spices and natural health products.

Valencia Club Cocina, Cooking Demonstration, Preparation of Local Specialities

After procuring the fresh, local ingredients necessary for your cooking demonstration and lunch, continue on to the Valencia Club Cocina. Upon arrival, your local chef will guide you through a narrated cooking demonstration. Along the way, watch and

learn as the chef shows you how to prepare a traditional menu featuring an authentic Spanish paella as the main dish, along with Spanish omelette and other popular local specialities. The room also has screens for an enhanced view whilst the chef prepares these dishes.

Wine Tasting, Chef's Toast, Meal

After the cooking demonstration, enjoy a tasting of renowned local wines, followed by a toast with the chef and meal consisting of the freshly-made dishes prepared during your cooking demonstration. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the short drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 219 yards (about 200 metres), at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and at the cooking class venue. Valencia, Carcaixent

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately one-hour drive to Carcaixent, a town and municipality in the province of Valencia, eastern Spain. Although Carcaixent dates from Neolithic, Iberian, and Roman times, it is perhaps best-known as the birthplace of orange and citrus tree growth in Valencia, and the industry has flourished since the 19th century. Valencia is renowned for its oranges and its orange trees are unique, producing sweet fruit with a hint of bitterness and a deep, orange hue often associated with the 'perfect' orange. The weather here is ideal for growing orange trees, with just the right mixture of rain and sunshine, and helps produce some of the best oranges in the world.

Colourful Orange & Lemon Groves, Mountains, Huerto Ribera, Gardens, Orange Trees, Flowers

Whilst driving towards the La Ribera region, take in spectacular panoramic views and photo opportunities of the fields of colourful orange and lemon trees, along with groves scattered throughout the countryside around the historic town of Carcaixent. Upon arrival at Huerto Ribera, take a guided walking tour of this historic, family-owned property. First, visit the monumental front house, which was built in 1870 and is surrounded by mountains and exquisite views of the area's natural beauty. Take a stroll through the gardens filled with centenary orange trees and all types of flowers, and delight in the intoxicating aroma of the orange blossoms.

Citrus Varieties & Picking, Tastings of Orange Juice, Home-Made Specialities & Spirits, Store

Learn about the orchard's history, traditional vs. modern orange cultivation, and pruning, irrigation, and grafting. See the many varieties of citrus trees planted here, including sanguinelli, citrus yuzu, Buddha hand, limes, citrus caviar, calamondin, kumquats, and limequats. You can even collect your own seasonal oranges or tangerines to take home (from September until June). Next, enjoy a tasting of freshly-squeezed orange juice, home-made specialities, such as jams, marmalades, and orange blossom honey, served with biscuits or cake, and Valencian spirits; all are available for purchase at the orchard's store. Following your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately one-hour drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking and standing for approximately 0.6 miles (about one kilometre), at times over uneven, natural, inclined and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and several at the venue. City Highlights Overview

We will start our day with a Panoramic Tour through the city. We will see the "City of Arts and Science", with the Hemispheric, which has become one of the most emblematic buildings in the new Valencia.

Ciutat Fallera, Museo del Artista Fallero, Fallero Artist

Following Turia river's shoreline we will head to the "Ciutat Fallera" (City of Fallas).

Here you can find the artists responsible for creating the Fallas monuments which will be placed in the city during mid-March and will be consumed by the flames in the Nit de la Crema.

We will make a stop in the Museo del Artista Fallero. This is a place where you collect the Ninots that are pardoned each year from getting burned.

Here, one of the local artists will guide you through a few of the several warehouses where you will get an explanation of the process of making a Ninot de la Falla and how will be taken to the street and finally burned. Get ready to be surrounded by a lot of art, colorful figures and magic shapes that will turn this in a breathtaking experience.

After the visit of the city of Fallas, we will reboard the bus and head downtown Valencia passing by the famous Palace "Marques de Dos Aguas". After this, we will admire the Bullring, and the "Torres de Serrano".

Walking tour

Our walking tour will begin in the Barri de Velluters, where we pass by the atelier shops, where each showcase presents amazing dresses that girls wear during the celebration of Las Fallas which are iconic in this festival together with the Ninots. In this quarter we will visit the Artisanal Silk Shop. Here you can find exclusive items, most of them handcrafted and made with natural Valencian silk.

El Casal, Meet a "Fallero", "Fallero snack", Walking Tour

We will continue our walk to "El Casal" this is the place where "falleros" meet during the year for dinners and meals. During the week of Fallas, the venue is like their second home. Each Falla has its own Casal. Here we will enjoy a typical snack and refreshment.

We will then continue with a pleasant walk through the city's old quarter. We will pass by the Town Hall building, Central Market and the Silk Market "La Lonja", which is one of the most famous gothic monuments in Europe and was declared as World Heritage by UNESCO. Continuing our stroll, we will get to the Round Square, Cathedral, Virgin Square and "Basílica de los Desamparados". All buildings are outside visits.

Return to the bus to enjoy a pleasant drive back to the port.

La Sagrada Familia

Many of the steeples Gaudí envisioned have not yet been built, and much of the structure is still exposed to the heavens. Take a walk around this unfinished church for photos before continuing your drive through the Eixample District.

Eixample District Tour

The Eixample District is home to some of Barcelona's most stunning examples of Modernist architecture, especially along the elegant Paseo de Gracia. Important buildings such as Gaudí's La Pedrera House and the Batlló House, and others such as the Amatller House, line up in this impressive thoroughfare.

Casa Batlló

Next, a visit is made to Casa Batlló. Originally a residence of a wealthy industrialist, Gaudí completely renovated the building between 1904 and 1906, and its façade is unsurpassed in the entire city. There are no corners; even the walls are rounded and the tile roof depicts the back of a dragon. Your guided walking tour of this Gaudí masterpiece includes the impressive main floor and rooftop, which features whimsical chimneys and offers spectacular views over the city.

Following your visit, re-board your coach for a drive to the Barcelona El Prat airport.

Barcelona, Montjuïc Hill, Olympic Ring, Olympic Games Buildings

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 30-minute drive along Montjuïc Hill. Montjuïc was claimed by the city on the occasion of the 1929 International Exposition. In preparation, the mountain was developed with trade fair halls, sports installations, and parks and gardens throughout; today, it is the most important recreational area in Barcelona. Upon arrival, pass through the Olympic Ring and marvel at Barcelona City from your coach whilst passing by the many buildings constructed for the 1992 Barcelona Olympic Games.

Poble Espanyol, Spanish Village Recreation, Shopping Stop

Your first stop features a guided tour of Poble Espanyol, a Spanish village on Montjuic Hill that was built for the 1929 International Exposition. This original project consisted of recreating the local architectural styles of each Spanish province. A village was built to represent an ideal model of 'Pueblo Iberico', which features replicas of around 116 buildings, squares and streets from all over Spain. The Spanish village also has large areas dedicated to Spanish art and crafts, where a stop is made to browse a variety of Spanish art, handicrafts and souvenirs.

Sagrada Familia, Exterior Photo Stop, Barceloneta, Local Restaurant, Spanish Lunch

Next, re-board your coach and drive towards the Modernist-style Sagrada Familia. This architectural gem on Barcelona's sprawling skyline is a reflection of the prodigal Catalan architect Antoni Gaudi's distinct imagination and style. Upon arrival, an exterior photo stop is made to marvel at its sublime façades. Leaving Sagrada Familia, re-board your coach and proceed for a traditional Spanish lunch at a lovely restaurant in the Barceloneta area.

Gothic Quarter, Cathedral (if allowed), Airport Transfer

After lunch, head to the Gothic Quarter. Upon arrival, take a guided stroll through the Gothic Quarter. Here, the remains of the Roman City survive here alongside medieval buildings, testaments to a glorious past in which the Catalan monarchy held its court for 500 years. Whilst in the Gothic Quarter, a visit is also made to the late-13th-century Cathedral, built by Jaume II in 1298. At the conclusion of your tour, re-board your coach and commence the approximately one-hour drive to the airport for your flight home.
