## ORGANISED SHORE EXCURSIONS

Booking Direct with Silversea gives you peace of mind. Our local tour operators are fully insured and have been comprehensively vetted. In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.

## BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore Excursions are available on a first-come, first served basis. Guests should note that some shore excursions are very popular with guests and often ending up being waitlisted. In order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via [my.silversea.com](http://my.silversea.com) until 48 hours prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate in excursions are subject to availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge Desk within the cancellation deadline. For our selected Shore Excursions Tickets returned after the cancellation deadline will be charged 100% cancellation fee to the guest's onboard account. Cancellation deadlines for the majority of our shore excursions is 48hrs prior to the port of call. Please note that certain shore excursions might have a different cancellation deadline; all cancellation deadlines are stated in the please note section of the shore excursion, booking form and shore excursion tickets.

Overland and exclusive excursions must be pre-paid by credit card through your reservation agents. If still available they may also be purchased on board. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. If this minimum number is not met, Silversea reserves the right to offer the programme at a different rate or to cancel the specific departure.

Guests are kindly requested to proceed ashore at least 10-minutes prior to the shore excursion departure time. ## SHORE EXCURSION SUITABILITY

Silversea offers a broad range of activities for our guests of all physical capabilities. However, certain excursions are more appropriate for physically fit and active guests. All excursions offered are clearly identified with an activity level to assist you. We also offer a good variety of Accesible Shore Excursion worldwide (according to the ports availability and local structure) that are designed for guests unable to negotiate motor coach steps or for full time wheelchair/scooter users. The vehicle used on this type of shore excursion is adapted with an access ramp (or lift where available) to accommodate a limited number of mobility devices. In order to use the ramp and/or lift, guests are required to be seated on a wheelchair or scooter. For your safety and enjoyment and that of your fellow guests, please be certain to select excursions that meet your physical capability. We therefore encourage guests to review the excursion description carefully including the PLEASE NOTE section which includes useful information. Silversea also offers Destination Experience

Briefings onboard. Please be aware that once arrangements are confirmed they are non-refundable.

## DESTINATION EXPERIENCE BRIEFINGS

Throughout the voyage the Shore Concierge Manager and Destination Consultant will offer port and shore excursion information prior to arrival in each port of call. Their aim is to give you a travel experience that goes beyond the ordinary and answer as many of your questions as possible. The information is presented in the theatre or is pre-recorded and played on your in-suite entertainment system, and will allow more time to enjoy and immerse yourself in each port.

## SILVERSEA SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary transportation may be provided by Silversea when the local town is beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists, preventing Silversea from providing a complimentary shuttle. The availability and schedule for this service will be announced onboard and listed in the Silversea Chronicles. We are not able to advise this in advance. Operationally, intervals between shuttle bus departures could be affected by local traffic. Silversea is not liable for any unforeseen delays. There will be a break in service for driver meal times. Shuttle service is offered during the day only. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation; guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

## CHILDREN ON TOUR

To ensure the safety of our younger guests, participation by children in certain shore excursions may be restricted. Children up to the age of 8 years old are only permitted to participate in suitable Silver Shore Excursions and the shuttle service if the vehicles are equipped with the correct safety harness and seating equipment. Such harnesses' and secure

seating cannot be guaranteed. Alternately, guests may use their own approved safety seat, booster seat or harness as long as they are compatible with the local touring vehicle and can properly secure the young guest. Silversea reserves the right to refuse children under the age of 8 years old on any tour on the basis of safety.

## VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY CHARGES

Please note that photography at some museums, sites and monuments and/or the use of video cameras may not be allowed or may incur a charge. These charges are not included in the tour price and are at guests' own expense. Further details will be in the detailed shore excursion description and please note section. Please ensure to review these in detail prior to departing on your shore excursion.

## SHOPPING STOPS

While our organised excursions are not generally geared to the serious shopper, some shore excursions allow for short shopping stops as indicated in the shore excursion description. ### BUE-004 / Inspiring Evita

Difficulty



Price: \$129 - Duration: 5.00 hr(s)



Trace the life and times of Eva (Evita) Peron on her way to becoming the iconic First Lady of Argentina during this scenic, half-day excursion to Buenos Aires.

#### **Buenos Aires, City Tour through the Eyes of Evita Peron**

This tour offers a unique opportunity to explore the streets and landmarks of Buenos Aires as seen through the eyes of Evita Peron. Along the way, learn about her early beginnings and work as a stage, radio and film actress en route to becoming the First Lady of Argentina. In addition, learn about her untimely death at the age of 33, saintly aura and the secrets behind the myth.

#### **Plaza de Mayo, Presidential Palace, Recoleta Cemetery, Evita's Tomb**

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 30-minute drive to the Plaza de Mayo, the political heart of Argentina. Upon arrival, see the Casa Rosada (Presidential Palace), and the famous balcony from which Evita addressed her adoring fans. From here, re-board your coach and continue on to the Recoleta Cemetery for a visit to Evita's Tomb.

#### **Evita Museum, Museum Café, Evita Performance, Refreshments, Lecture by a Museum Expert**

Your next stop is at the Evita Museum, where the story of her life unfolds through her personal objects. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of the museum, which is housed in a mansion where her charity, the Eva Peron Foundation, once gave shelter to single mothers. During your museum visit, or in Recoleta, enjoy a short 'Evita' performance. Afterward, proceed to the museum's café for refreshments and a lecture by one of the museum's experts. Following your visit, your tour concludes with an approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.

**Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking and standing for approximately 0.5 miles (about 0.8 kilometres), at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and 10-15 steps at the Evita Museum. This tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility, but is not wheelchair-accessible. Lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Guests must be at least five years old to participate on this tour. Photography/videography of certain exhibits (Evita's dresses, costumes, etc.) in the museum is prohibited. The tour sequence may vary. Space on this tour is very limited; we suggest you book in advance to avoid disappointment.**

### BUE-006 / The Art of Tango: Performances & Lesson

Experience an exclusive tango performance and learn how to perform this wonderful dance during this interactive, half-day tango excursion.

Buenos Aires, La Boca, Caminito, Atelier

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 30-minute drive to La Boca, the most colourful barrio (neighbourhood) in Buenos Aires. Much of La Boca's colour emanates from the brightly-painted houses and corrugated metal roofs of the Caminito, a popular pedestrian walk and former railroad terminus that takes its name from a popular tango. During a stop here, artists offer

their pictures representing Caminito Street or typical tango scenes. A visit is also made to the Atelier, an historic house known as a conventillo (tenement block), a classic building of Buenos Aires culture.

San Telmo, San Telmo Market, Free Time

Next, re-board your coach and continue on to the barrio of San Telmo, an artist's quarter where bohemians find large spaces and low rents. San Telmo is the best-kept area and oldest district of Buenos Aires. Upon arrival, some free time is made available to browse the San Telmo Market. Leaving San Telmo, continue on to a Tango House.

Tango House, Refreshments, Tango Performance, Interactive Tango Lesson

Upon arrival, enjoy refreshments with a snack and take in a passionate tango performance. The tango ideally reflects the origins and feelings of the immigrants, as well as their nostalgic and bohemian lifestyle of the late-1800s. Afterward, you are invited to participate in a tango lesson. Learn the basic steps of this mesmerizing dance with its hypnotic moves and gestures, including the 'walk', 'rock', 'stroll' and 'chase'. At the conclusion of this unforgettable tango experience, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

**Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking and standing for approximately 547 yards (about 500 metres), at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and 20-25 steps at the sites visited; a lift is available. This tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility, but is not wheelchair-accessible. Lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. The tour sequence may vary. Space on this tour is very limited; we suggest you book in advance to avoid disappointment.**

## BUE-013 / Street Art in Buenos Aires

Discover why Buenos Aires has become one of the world's most exciting cities for street art during this captivating, half-day sightseeing excursion.

Buenos Aires, Palermo, Street Art, Meet Local Artists

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 30-minute drive to the Palermo area. The extraordinary history of the vibrant urban art culture, from its fiery political origins to the modern context, is revealed during street art tours of the city's graffiti hotspots. Upon arrival at Palermo, the first of four different graffiti hotspots in Buenos Aires to be visited during this tour, which was developed in close collaboration with the city's leading artists. Along the way, view unique, colourful, and deeply-symbolic street art adorning the walls of local buildings, meet local artists, and learn about their personal stories and motivations.

Villa Crespo, Chacarita, Street Art

Next, re-board your coach and continue on to your second and third stops, the Villa Crespo and Chacarita areas, for an up-close look at their spectacular street art and many wonderful photo opportunities of your surrounds.

Colegiales, Street Art, Flea Market, Free Time

Your final stop is at the Colegiales street art area. Upon arrival, view the area's spectacular street art, followed by some free time to browse the flea market at your leisure. At the conclusion of your tour, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

**Please note: This tour involves an extensive amount of walking and standing for approximately 2.1 miles (about 3.4 kilometres), at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and up to 20 steps at the sites visited. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sun protection, bottled water, and US Dollars, Euros, local currency, or credit cards for purchases from the ship. The tour sequence may vary. Space on this tour is extremely limited; we suggest you book well in advance to avoid disappointment.**



## BUE-014 / Parks and Gardens

Explore the beautiful parks and gardens of Buenos Aires during this picturesque, half-day sightseeing excursion.

Buenos Aires, Botanical Garden, Roman, French & Oriental Gardens, Herbarium, Greenhouses

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 40-minute drive to the Botanical Garden. One of the city's most important spaces for the protection, exhibition, and study of plants and their species, the Botanical Garden spans approximately 17 acres (about seven hectares). Its collection of 6,000 tree and plant species is grouped into regions, and includes a collection of native Argentine flora. The Botanical Garden also features a Botanical Library, Roman, French, and Oriental gardens, an herbarium, and five greenhouses.

Palermo Woods, Magnificent Groves & Lakes, Rose Garden, Water Fountains, Bandstand

The tour continues with a walk in the Palermo Woods, the biggest green space in the city with its magnificent groves and lakes. From here, take a stroll through the park's crowned jewel of the park, the beautiful (Rosedal) Rose Garden. Along the way, marvel at over 8,000 roses spanning 93 species, water fountains, and bandstand.

Japanese Garden

Leaving the Rose Garden, re-board your coach and head for a final stop at the Japanese Garden, declared a 'place of historical interest'. Upon arrival, learn about and delight in the garden's typical Japanese cultural design, a legacy of the Japanese heritage in Argentina. At the conclusion of your tour, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

**Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking and standing for approximately 0.6 miles (about one kilometre), at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and 20-25 steps at the Japanese and Botanical gardens. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sun protection, bottled water, and US Dollars, Euros, local currency, or credit cards for purchases from the ship. The tour sequence may vary. Space on this tour is very limited; we suggest you book in advance to avoid disappointment.**

## BUE-015 / Paraná Delta & Tigre River by Yacht

Experience the splendid beauty of the northern part of Buenos Aires during this scenic, half-day coach and cruise on Tigre River.

San Isidro Tour & Cathedral

Depart the pier for a scenic drive north to the Tigre River. En route, pass by the narrow, tree-lined streets of residential neighbourhoods, yacht clubs and mansions. An exterior photo stop is made at the San Isidro Cathedral (although not guaranteed, an interior visit to the cathedral may be made)

Tigre River Cruise by Private Yacht

Next, proceed to Tigre River. For more than 100 years, the maze of rivers and channels of the Tigre Delta has been a favourite weekend gateway for Porteños, or inhabitants of Buenos Aires. Upon arrival at the boat dock, embark your private yacht for a relaxing, one-hour cruise. Along the way, enjoy some refreshments while exploring the green labyrinths of the river's channels, streams and islands. Your river route is interspersed with views of beautiful riverside villas, Victorian docks, English gardens, and traditional rowing and boating clubs.

Following your cruise, disembark the boat and re-board your coach for the approximate 50-minute return drive to the pier.

**Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 328 yards (300 metres). Guests should be able to get on and off the buses, and negotiate the 10-15 steps necessary to embark / disembark the boat without assistance. A restroom is available on the boat.**

## BUE-A / Buenos Aires Highlights

Difficulty

Buenos Aires is the capital and largest city of Argentina, and the second largest metropolitan area in South America. A top tourist destination known for its European-style architecture and rich cultural life, Buenos Aires defines itself as a multicultural city, being home to multiple ethnic and religious groups.

### La Boca and El Caminito

Depart the pier for a drive along the magnificent Avenida 9 de Julio, reputed to be the widest boulevard on earth, here is where you will begin your tour of Buenos Aires with a visit to the La Boca District. Along the way, see the colourful buildings of the 'barrio' and the brightly-painted walls, murals and sculptures during a stroll down the famous pedestrian street of El Caminito.

### San Telmo and Plaza de Mayo

Next, your drive continues through the charming streets of San Telmo, where mansions of yesteryear have been subdivided into crowded one- and two-bedroom dwellings known as 'conventillos'. From here, drive to the downtown area and take a stroll through May Square, or 'Plaza de Mayo'. Along the way, visit the historic Government House and Cathedral.

### Obelisk

Re-board your coach and proceed for refreshments at a traditional cafeteria. Afterward, re-board your coach and drive past the dramatic Obelisk, a memorial monument and revered symbol of Buenos Aires.

### La Recoleta and Palermo

Your tour concludes with a brief stop at the La Recoleta Cemetery, the oldest cemetery in the city. In addition to its lavish marble statuary, mausoleums and tombs, La Recoleta is renowned for the esteemed national figures that are interred here, notably Eva (Evita) Perón.

Following your visit, re-board your coach for a drive through Palermo, home of magnificent mansions and parks, before returning to the pier.

**Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 328 yards (300 metres) with stairs to negotiate at the cathedral, a few steps at the cemetery and cobblestone surfaces at El Caminito. Guests should be able to get on/off the buses without assistance. Proper attire is required to enter the cathedral; shorts and bare shoulders are not permitted. The tour sequence may vary. A minimum number of guests per guide are required to operate this programme.**

## BUE-F / Tigre Delta River Cruise

#### Punta del Este

After tendering ashore, depart the pier for the approximate 45-minute sightseeing drive through Punta del Este. Along the way, see the Peninsula, Brava Beach and the open-air collection of sculptures at the Square of the Americas. 'The Hand', a sculpture created in 1981 by Mario Yrarrázabal of Chile, has become a city icon. From here, drive through the residential areas of San Rafael and Golf Park en route to the Beverly Hills District, home of the Ralli Museum of Contemporary Art.

#### Ralli Museum of Contemporary Art

The Ralli Museum of Contemporary Art is an attractive, modern museum featuring a fine collection of paintings and sculptures by noted Latin American artists, along with works by European master Dalí. Next, drive past the Rincon del Indio neighborhood, Indian Corner and stop for photos at La Barra de Maldonado, known for its hanging bridge.

#### Casapueblo Private Atelier

Punta Del Este, Maldonado Coast & Countryside Drive, Piriápolis, Cerro del Toro Winery

The latter is the white variety (chardonnay, viognier, and pinot grigio) emblem of the winery. The rest of the vines are pinot noir, cabernet franc, syrah, petit verdot, gamaret, and lacrima christi. Upon arrival at Cerro del Toro, you are welcomed and escorted on a guided walking tour of the vineyard. Afterward, learn how to select the best cuts of meat, choose the firewood, and ignite and maintain the fire to achieve the desired cooking point.

### Olive Oil Farm Visit and Tasting

The Extra Virgin olive oils are produced from estate own olives, harvested by hand. They undergo a cold extraction system with Perialisi technology. Upon extraction, they are stored in stainless steel tanks under controlled atmosphere. All our oils have an acidity lower than 0.2 %. Your visit is highlighted by a taste of 3 different olive oils, cheeses and homemade breads. Unipraises Park, Cable-Car-Ride, Barra Sul Station, Aguada Hill

## Itajaí

Itajaí lying at the mouth of the Itajaí River and founded in 1860, is home to the largest fishing port and university in Brazil.

### Itajaí Cathedral

Upon arrival, take a guided tour of the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament. Built in 1940, the Cathedral is currently the biggest artistic and cultural monument of the city. It features romantic elements and paintings of Italian artists Emilio Cease and Aldo Locatelli, along with six towers, 55 stained glass Biblical motifs, a panel of the Immaculate Conception of the Virgin Mary in the roof, and a statue of Moses descending from Mount Sinai.

### Balneário Camboriú

The city is the Tourism Capital of Santa Catarina, due to the tourist facilities, beautiful beach, infrastructure and diversity of hotels. On the way back to the pier, you will visit the viewpoint on the Barra Sul footbridge that leads to the Barra neighborhood, the oldest in the city, a contrast between the past and the present. The fauna is also quite diverse, including approximately 130 species of birds belonging to 37 families, along with reptiles, amphibians, and mammals such as the lesser anteater, opossum, wildcat, and cotia. Water and snacks are provided. At the conclusion of your tour, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.

Itajaí, Scenic Drive, Pomerode

Here, approximately 50 listed, half-timber houses were built over an approximately 10-mile (about 16-kilometre) area in a valley of fields planted with corn, sugarcane, and palm trees, and surrounded by the hills of the Atlantic Forest.

Siewert House, Nugali Chocolate Factory, City Centre, Lunch, Pomeranian Museum

Next, a visit is made Siewert House, preserved by the same family that arrived in Brazil in 1868, to learn how immigrants lived and worked. Leaving Siewert House, head to the Nugali Chocolate Factory, the most-awarded Brazilian chocolate in the world, for a tour and chocolate tasting. Continue on to the small and charming centre of Pomerode for lunch at Biergarten Pomerania, a casual and traditional restaurant.

At the conclusion of your tour, re-board your coach and commence the approximately two-hour drive back to the pier.

Among the highlights of the guided walk are curiosities and legends unique to the island, including one involving a golden angel statue the size of an adult man, long ago buried by the Jesuits in the vicinity of a rock known as the Stone of the Cross. The rock's chiseled inscriptions are said to date back 4,000 years \ and might actually be a map to find the golden angel. You'll have to decide what you believe.

In addition to the trail's beautiful flora and fauna , you'll encounter an elevated gazebo with fantastic island views and an orchid-decorated refuge for animals and wild birds.

Lunch & Beach Time



Following the modest rigors of the hike, your next two hours will be completely relaxed. Lunch is served at the isle's beachside restaurant; choose from Shrimp Porto Belo, fish of the day, or filet medallions \ all accompanied by side dishes, acai dessert, and two caipirinhas, beers, or juices/sodas. After spending the balance of your free island time either along the beach or exploring the nearby environs, a 15-minute boat spin brings you back to the mainland and your coach, staged for the 45-minute return drive to the pier.

Crown your day at the stunning Oscar Niemeyer Museum, housed in a distinctive eye-shaped building. Known locally as "The Eye," this architectural marvel showcases Latin American contemporary art across more than 376,000 sq ft / 35,000 sq m of exhibition space, offering a fitting finale to your urban exploration.

On this journey, pristine Atlantic Forest meets golden beaches, creating an unspoiled landscape that hosts rich biodiversity and some of Brazil's most picturesque shorelines.

### IHB-A / Ilhabela Historic City & Toca Waterfalls

Difficulty

Enjoy your day on the amazing island of Ilhabela and visit some of the main sites as well as Waterfall Park where you will discover the island is home to some 360 waterfalls in total.

#### Barreiro's Viewpoint

Departing from the pier, board an air-conditioned van for an approximately one-hour visit to the downtown area, stopping for photos at the Barreiro's Viewpoint.

#### Nossa Senhora D'Ajuda

Next, make your way to Ilhabela's foremost church; Nossa Senhora D'Ajuda built in 1806. Be provided an interior guided visit and see why so many find this small Catholic Church to be so captivating.

#### Waterfall Municipal Park

Continue past the Princess' House en route to the Waterfall Municipal Park. Once there, enjoy the short 15-minute drive to the Toca Waterfalls, or Waterfall Park as the locals call it. The falls are on the site of an old sugar and banana plantation that was built in 1937 for the production of cachaça, a distilled spirit from Brazil that is a style of rum.

You'll have approximately 1-hour to explore the Toca Falls with a guided visit to the three main falls.

Taste the famous cachaça before your return trip to the Pier.

**Please note: This tour requires a minimal amount of walking at times over unpaved surfaces as well as approximately 60 steps to climb in total. The approximate distance covered will be 300 metres. #### Brazilian Schooner Cruise

Depart directly from the pier area on your wooden schooner for an approximately one-hour sail to Jabaquara Beach. Beautiful beaches, more than 300 waterfalls and an enormous variety of the Atlantic Rain Forest's fauna and flora are all factors that helped name the island "Ilhabela" - the beautiful island. Approximately 85% of the island is defined as a national park and is designated by UNESCO as a national patrimony and one of the last untouched areas of the Atlantic Rainforest.

#### Jabaquara Beach

Take a small boat ashore at Jabaquara Beach, one of Brazil's most treasured stretches of sand, for a few hours of relaxation, swimming and sun bathing. With soft sands and cut by two crystalline creeks, Jabaquara Beach offers enchantment, tranquility

and a special charm. Even for non-swimmers the beauty of the scenery and white sand beaches alternating with the green and blue waters of the ocean and greenery make this a most enjoyable outing.

Light refreshments are included.

The schooner, on its way to Jabaquara Beach, passes by the beaches of Barreiros, Viana, and Sino, famous for its rocks that resemble the sound of church bells. Passing the historic Ponta das Canas lighthouse, disembark at Jabaquara Beach which is surrounded by the stunning rainforest.

Jeep Ride

At the same time the schooner departs, the jeep leaves towards Jabaquara Beach passing by Barreiros viewpoint to make a quick stop for pictures with your ship in the background. Still on the way, visit distinctive Sino's beach, where you can not only see but also "hear" the rocks. Continuing after Ponta das Canas Lighthouse is a dirt road leading you to Jabaquara Beach.

Relax on the beach

Whether you arrive by boat or jeep, relax and enjoy the beauty of this beach with around 1.5 hours of leisure time to sunbathe, swim or take in the view of the magnificent sea. On the way back, all guests who went by jeep, will return by schooner and vice versa, making the same route back.

Depart the pier with your driver/guide in an open-air, 4X4 Jeep for the short drive to the Cabras Island Viewpoint. Upon arrival, enjoy an exquisite view of the São Sebastião Canal. After a brief photo stop here, re-board your coach and head to the Tres Tombos (Three Falls) Waterfalls, one of 360 waterfalls that the island has to offer. The Three Falls are located close to Feiticeira Beach, with the largest fall towering over 65 feet (about 20 metres) in height. During your visit, you may opt to take a refreshing swim in the natural pool and enjoy the natural spray created by the running waters.



Curral Beach, Free Time, Sunbathing, Beachcombing, Swimming

Next, re-board your Jeep and continue towards the southern part of the island for a visit to Curral Beach, one of the most famous beaches on the island. During your approximately 1.5-hour visit, relax and soak up the sun amidst the natural beauty of your surrounds, take a stroll on the sandy beach, and/or swim in the warm, inviting waters at your leisure. Food and beverages are available at local restaurants and bars at Curral Beach at your own expense. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 45-minute drive back to the pier.
