ORGANISED SHORE EXCURSIONS

In the unlikely event of issues with a Silversea tour, we assume responsibility and the ship will wait for our delayed shore excursion. These are important factors when comparing value. Please bear in mind as we traverse many far reaching destinations, the local infrastructure varies and is beyond our control. Road conditions and vehicles available locally may not be up to standards we are accustomed to. Guides and drivers may speak with a heavy accent at times depending on the port of call. Be assured however that at Silversea, we contract only the best tours and best operators available at each destination. Please Note: Silversea reserves the right to make any changes or modify a tour in case of unforeseen circumstances and/or to ensure the safety and comfort of our quests.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION DEADLINES

Shore Excursions are available on a first-come, first served basis. Guests should note that some shore excursions are very popular with guests and often ending up being waitlisted. In order to avoid disappointment, it is therefore suggested to book in advance via my.silversea.com until 48 hours prior to sailing. Last-minute requests to participate in excursions are subject to availability, which in some cases may not be determined until departure time pier-side. If changes or cancellations are required once onboard, tickets must be returned to the Shore Concierge Desk within the cancellation deadline. For our selected Shore Excursions Tickets returned after the cancellation deadline will be charged 100% cancellation fee to the guest's onboard account. Cancellation deadlines for the majority of our shore excursions is 48hrs prior to the port of call. Please note that certain shore excursions might have a different cancellation deadline; all cancellation deadlines are stated in the please note section of the shore excursion, booking form and shore excursion tickets.

Silversea offers a broad range of activities for our guests of all physical capabilities. However, certain excursions are more appropriate for physically fit and active guests. All excursions offered are clearly identified with an activity level to assist you. We also offer a good variety of Accesible Shore Excursion worldwide (according to the ports availability and local structure) that are designed for guests unable to negotiate motor coach steps or for full time wheelchair/scooter users. The vehicle used on this type of shore excursion is adapted with an access ramp (or lift where available) to accommodate a limited number of mobility devices. In order to use the ramp and/or lift, guests are required to be seated on a wheelchair or scooter. For your safety and enjoyment and that of your fellow guests, please be certain to select excursions that meet your physical capability. We therefore encourage guests to review the excursion description carefully including the PLEASE NOTE section which includes useful information. Silversea also offers Destination Experience

The information is presented in the theatre or is pre-recorded and played on your in-suite entertainment system, and will allow more time to enjoy and immerse yourself in each port.

SILVERSEA SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary transportation may be provided by Silversea when the local town is beyond a reasonable walking distance from the port. This service may not be possible in ports where a strong taxi union exists, preventing Silversea from providing a complimentary shuttle. The availability and schedule for this service will be announced onboard and listed in the Silversea Chronicles. We are not able to advise this in advance. Operationally, intervals between shuttle bus departures could be affected by local traffic. Silversea is not liable for any unforeseen delays. There will be a break in service for driver meal times. Shuttle service is offered during the day only. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation; guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

CHILDREN ON TOUR

To ensure the safety of our younger guests, participation by children in certain shore excursions may be restricted. Children up to the age of 8 years old are only permitted to participate in suitable Silver Shore Excursions and the shuttle service if the vehicles are equipped with the correct safety harness and seating equipment. Such harnesses' and secure

seating cannot be guaranteed. Alternately, guests may use their own approved safety seat, booster seat or harness as long as they are compatible with the local touring vehicle and can properly secure the young guest. Silversea reserves the right to refuse children under the age of 8 years old on any tour on the basis of safety.

VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY CHARGES

Please note that photography at some museums, sites and monuments and/or the use of video cameras may not be allowed or may incur a charge. KOJ-A / Landscapes of Kagoshima

Difficulty



Price: \$149 - Duration: 5.25 hr(s)

Explore the highlights of Japan's 'Southern Gateway' via land and water during this scenic sightseeing excursion to Kagoshima and its environs.

Iso Gardens and La Maison Goten

Depart the pier for the approximate 40-minute drive to the 17th-century Iso Gardens, or 'Senganen'. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of the exquisite gardens. The gardens feature beautiful flowers, rock pools, small bridges and shrines, and offer splendid vistas of the sea, the Sakurajima Volcano and the city of Kagoshima. An interior visit is also made to La Maison "GOTEN", which was once used as the main residence of the head of the Shimadzu family and as a guest house, to which domestic and foreign dignitaries were invited. The beautiful decorations inside the residence, as well as the living room where the garden can be seen at its most beautiful, and audience room are highlights of this house.

Sakurajima and Arimura Point

Next, re-board your coach and drive to the Kagoshima Ferry Port and embark a ferry for the brief ride to Sakurajima. Upon arrival, disembark the ferry and drive to Arimura Point. Here, a visit is made to the Arimura Observatory for a spectacular view of Mt. Sakura, which rises over 3000 feet (1000 metres) above the waters of Kagoshima Bay. The volcano has had over 30 major eruptions in recorded history and is still experiencing minor eruptions almost daily.

Kagoshima

Following your visit to Arimura Point, re-board your coach for the return drive to the Sakurajima Ferry Port and embark a ferry for the ride back to Kagoshima.

Your tour concludes with an approximate 45-minute transfer back to the pier.

This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 0.9 miles (about 1.5 kilometres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach, 100 steps or a steep slope at Arimura Point, slopes, 50 steps and gravel surfaces at the Iso Garden and 20 steps to embark/disembark the ferry. Ferry is not exclusive to Silversea guests. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing, sun protection and sunglasses to protect your eyes from ash particles that may be present. Guests are required to take off shoes to visit La Maison "GOTEN". The tour sequence may vary. Japanese yen is required for any purchases: guests are advised to exchange money at the airport prior the cruise. Local Tour Guides tend to have a strong accent therefore we urge flexibility. The duration of the tour may vary depending on the docking position.

KOJ-C / Chiran Samurai Residence & Peace Museum

Difficulty



Price: \$159 - Duration: 4.00 hr(s)

Explore the history and traditions of Kagoshima during this memorable, half-day excursion to the historic Samurai Houses at Chiran and tour a museum dedicated to World War II kamikaze pilots.

Satsuma Peninsula & Chiran Samurai House

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximate 50-minute drive along the Satsuma Peninsula. Along the way, an exterior visit is made at the Chiran Samurai House. During Japan's Feudal Era, Chiran was a stronghold of the Shimazu Samurai. During your visit, take a guided stroll down a street lined with well-preserved Samurai houses (exterior view) and their gardens.

Kamikaze Museum

Next, re-board your coach for the drive to the Kamikaze Museum. During World War II, the Chiran Air Base was home to Japan's Kamikaze squadrons. Visit the museum at your leisure. See the Tokko Heiwa Kaikan and its comprehensive collection of aircraft, models, mementoes and photographs of the Special Attack Corps. Please note that some signage is in Japanese only. Guide will provide necessary explanation before entering the museum.

Following your visit, commence the approximate one-hour drive back to the pier.

This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 0.7 miles (1.126 metres), with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and at the Samurai House's garden. It is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing, and bring sunscreen, a hat and sunglasses from the ship. This tour includes sensitive material, including graphic pictures and displays of the atrocities of war. No photograph at Kamikaze museum. The tour sequence may vary. Japanese yen is required for any purchases: guests are advised to exchange money at the airport prior the cruise. Local Tour Guides tend to have a strong accent therefore we urge flexibility. The duration of the tour may vary depending on the docking position.

KOJ-E / Ibusuki Sand Bath - Japanese Style Hot Springs Experience

Difficulty



Price: \$249 - Duration: 4.75 hr(s)

Ibusuki is an onsen town located in southern Kagoshima Prefecture. Unlike other onsen towns in Kyushu, Ibusuki is famous for its sand baths.

Scenic drive & photo stop at Lake Ikeda

Before heading to Sand Bath, make a memorable photo stop at Lake Ikeda which is the biggest volcanic lake in Kyushu, with a circumference of 15 kilometers and a surface area of 11 square km, and a depth of up to 233 meters. The almost round shaped lake is a caldera lake formed more than 6400 years ago because of volcanic activity in the area. Being a caldera lake, there are no rivers flowing in or out of the lake, and is entirely dependent on rainfall to maintain its water level. From Lake Ikeda you can see Mt. Kaimondake, a mountain rising 924 meters above sea level. It is commonly known as the "Fuji of Satsuma".

Ibusuki, Sand bath Experience & Hot Springs

The Sand Bath Experience is the most unique hot springs in the world, as "bathers" are buried in sand, rather than submerged in water. The heat and weight of the sand have an oddly refreshing and cleansing effect.

Upon arrival after the approximately one-hour scenic drive, receive your light Japanese robes "Yukata" and instructions to lie in the volcanic black sand. All but your head will then be covered with steaming sand, which is naturally heated from the underground hot springs. The benefits of being covered in hot sand may include improved blood circulation, detoxification, increased blood-oxygen levels throughout the body and highly valued beauty treatment for the skin. Be prepared to sweat much like you would in a sauna or steam bath, as your pores will quickly open up in the hot sand. Sessions typically last about 15 minutes, after which you will be helped out of the sand and shown to the hot springs to wash off and enjoy the outer bath.

Afterwards, commence your approximately one-hour drive back to the ship.

Important Note:

Japanese hot springs are enjoyed naked. Swimming suits are not allowed. It's permitted to bring a small towel into the bathing area, with which you can enhance your privacy while outside of the water. Once entered the bath, the towel must be kept out of the water. During the sand bath Guests will wear their Yukata only (light Japanese robes) that is provided together with shampoo, conditioner, body soap. The sanding bath area as well as the hot springs are not privately reserved for Silversea Guests only. The sand bathing area is mixed while the hot springs are separated for female-only and male-only. The use of the Sand Bath is forbidden after the consumption of alcoholic beverages. It's also forbidden for women who are pregnant or during their menstruation period. Photography and video cameras are not permitted inside the sand bath and hot springs. Tattoos are not permitted in the facility, however if they can be covered by a sticker or by yukata robe, you will be able to enjoy the Sand Bath.

This tour involves a minimal amount of walking with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and 20 steps at the sand bath. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility. Elevators are not available at the site. Japanese yen is required for any purchases: guests are advised to exchange money at the airport prior the cruise. Local Tour Guides tend to have a strong accent therefore we urge flexibility. The duration of the tour may vary depending on the docking position.

KOJ-G / Iso Garden & Sushi Experience

Difficulty



Price: \$249 - Duration: 4.75 hr(s)

Indulge your senses with the exquisite gardens and flavours of the 'Southern Gateway' to Japan during this delightful, half-day garden and sushi excursion to Kagoshima.

Kagoshima, Iso Garden, Shoko Shuseikan Museum (outside view) and La Maison Goten

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximate 40-minute drive to the 17th-century Senganen Gardens (Iso Garden). Upon arrival, take a guided tour of these exquisite gardens, which feature beautiful flowers, rock pools, small bridges and shrines, and offer breath-taking panoramic vistas of the sea, Sakurajima Volcano and Kagoshima City. Your tour continues with an outside visit to the adjacent Shoko Shuseikan Museum, which chronicles the 700-year history of the Shimazu Samurai. Visit La Maison Goten, which was once used as the main residence of the head of the Shimazu family and as a guest house to which domestic and foreign dignitaries were invited. The beautiful decorations inside the residence, as well as the living room where the garden can be seen at its most beautiful, and audience room are highlights of this house.

Fish Preparation and Demonstration, Traditional Sushi Lunch

Next, re-board your coach and proceed to a local 'kaiten-zushi' restaurant, which offers sushi dishes to its diners on a conveyor belt. Guests can freely pick the dishes they like as they pass in front of them, or order dishes that are not available on the conveyor belt. Usually, the number of plates is counted to determine the cost at the end of the meal; this is how the Kaiten-zushi restaurant works. For this special arrangement, you are asked to pick up (or order) any dishes, and eat as much as you want. Also, observe a demonstration of how fresh is 'broken up', and sit down to a sushi lunch. After lunch, re-board your coach for the short drive back to the pier.

This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 0.5 miles (about 0.8 kilometres), at times over uneven surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and 50 steps at the sites visited. This tour is not suitable for guests with food allergies, guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended. Guests must be at least 21 years old to be served alcoholic beverages. The fish that is 'broken up' and served is generally tuna; however, this is subject to availability and other fish may be substituted. The tour sequence may vary. Space on this tour is very limited; we suggest you book in advance to avoid disappointment. Ferry is not exclusive to Silversea guests. Japanese Yen is required for any purchases. The view from the observatory is weather dependent. Guests are required to take off shoes to visit La Maison "GOTEN".

The view from the observatory is weather dependent. Guests are required to take off shoes to visit La Maison "GOTEN". Local Tour Guides tend to have a strong accent therefore we urge flexibility. Shoko Shuseikan Museum is under construction of seismic reinforcement until October in 2024, so ONLY outside visit is possible. The duration of the tour may vary depending on the docking position.

KOJ-M / Sakurajima Volcano & Arimura Observatory

Difficulty



Price: \$149 - Duration: 4.25 hr(s)

Mt. Sakurajima, Foot Bath

You will reach Mt. Sakurajima by coach followed by a short ferry ride. It is an active stratovolcano, formerly an island and now a peninsula. Its summit has three peaks. The lava flows of the 1914 eruption connected it with the Osumi Peninsula. It is still the most active volcano in Japan. The volcanic activity still continues, dropping volcanic ash on the surroundings. Earlier eruptions built the white sand highlands in the region.

Mt. Sakurajima also has hot springs. You will make a stop at the Visitor Center to learn about Mt. Sakurajima, and Yogan Nagisa Park to try a Foot Bath.

Arimura Lava Observatory

Continue to the Arimura Lava Observatory, located on a small hill, which was created by an eruption in 1946. Enjoy views of Sakurajima and Kinko Bay while walking along the ¾ mile promenade. The volcano has had over 30 major eruptions in recorded history and is still experiencing minor eruptions almost daily. As the observatory is close to the crater of the steep cone shaped South Peak, it is guite possible you may hear explosive sounds from the crater.

Following your visit to Arimura Observatory, re-board your coach for the return drive to the Sakurajima Ferry Port and embark a ferry for the ride back to Kagoshima.

Your tour concludes with an approximate 45-minute transfer back to the pier.

This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 800 meters, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach. There are 300 meters walking to the Shiroyama Observatory and approximately 100 steaps at Arimura Observatory. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and those who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing, and bring sunscreen, a hat and sunglasses from the ship. Towels are not provided during this tour, guests are advised to bring their own from the ship. The tour sequence may vary. Japanese yen is required for any purchases: guests are advised to exchange money at the airport prior the cruise. Local Tour Guides tend to have a strong accent therefore we urge flexibility. The duration of the tour may vary depending on the docking position.

NGS-A / Nagasaki Memorial

Peace Memorial Park

Urakami Cathedral and Torii Gate

Marvel at the scenic beauty and storied history of western Japan during this scenic, full-day excursion to the Shimabara Peninsula, with a visit to the Fugen Volcano.

Shimabara Peninsula and Castle Museum

Depart the pier for the approximate two-hour drive east of Nagasaki and past picturesque Ariake Bay en route to the Shimabara Peninsula. Upon arrival, a visit is made to the early-17th century Shimabara Castle, the traditional centre of Shimabara City. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of the renovated castle, which now serves as a museum of Christian history.

View displays of old swords, armour and other items from the Edo period, along with a commemoration to the 1990 eruption of Mt. Unzen.

Shimabara Town and Samurai House

Following your tour of the castle, embark on a walking tour of Shimabara. A manmade waterway built in the middle of this old town once provided fresh water for the local residents. Today, this waterway is home to many beautiful Japanese carp. Samurai warriors once lived within and outside the castle grounds. During your stroll through Shimabara, a visit is made to a Samurai house.

Unzen Jigoku Hot Spring

After having lunch at local restaurant, your stop is Unzen Jigoku Hot Spring; a hot spring resort town near the peak of Mount Unzen. The resort is surrounded on several sides by hot spring fields. Also known as hells (jigoku), these barren rocky areas are littered with billowing steam vents and gushing hot springs from which milky, acidic and sulfurous water bubbles straight up out of the ground. The hells were once used to execute Christian rebels after the failed Shimabara Rebellion, but today its spring water has the more pleasant task of warming up holidaymakers in the ryokan baths around town.

Obama Hot Spring 105 (Foot Bath)

Your last stop is Obama Hot Spring 105 foot bath. Obama is set against a backdrop of the magnificent Mt.Unzen facing the deep-blue Tachibana Bay. From the open-air hot spring, you can view the amazing sunset in the west. At 105 meters in length, this is the longest foot bath in Japan. It is equipped with steaming pots for cooking local seafood and vegetables over the natural steam from the hot springs.

The coach then begins the nearly 1.5-hour drive back to the pier and your awaiting ship.

Your last stop is at the adjacent Glover Garden, situated on a picturesque hillside looking over Nagasaki Port, you will find a number of late 19th and early 20th century Western-style buildings gathered together.

Following your visit, commence the brief drive back to the pier.

Your tour begins with a scenic drive to Inasayama Natural Park, located on Inasayama Hill.

Inasayama Natural Park

This is a famous spot for beautiful sunsets and night views. If weather permits, enjoy a view of Unzen, Amakusa and Gotoh Islands. You will enjoy a ride on the popular monorail up the hillside. The car will take you to the upper level of Mount Inasa, from where you will walk up to the observatory that sits atop the mountain. From the peak, you will have an almost 360-degree aerial view of the city and be able to see the picturesque surroundings that change season to season.

Nagasaki Peace Park

Continue to the Nagasaki Peace Park, dedicated to World Peace. The park covers 8 acres and contains a large fountain and different statues and sculptures donated in the name of peace from various countries and artists around the world. The main statue is 30 feet tall and was commissioned by the city of Nagasaki. It depicts a man with one arm raised to the sky to indicate the threat of nuclear destruction and the other arm held horizontally in a gesture of peace. The man's eyelids are closed in anguished prayer for those who perished in the bombing.

Uragami Cathedral

Next, continue your drive and see Uragami Cathedral, which was the largest cathedral in the East until it was destroyed by the atomic bomb blast. View Dejima, once an artificial island in the port of Nagasaki, completed in 1636, to house Japan's Portuguese residents. After the Portuguese were exiled by the Edo Shogunate, the Dutch Vereenigde Oostindische Compagnie was moved to this Island in 1641 in an attempt to to take the Dutch trade away from the Hirado Clan. Today, Dejima is no longer an island, as the surrounding area has been reclaimed during the 20th century. However, a number of Dejima's historical structures remain or are being reconstructed in the area.

Following your visit, commence the approximate 20-minute drive back to the pier

Nagasaki Museum of History and Culture

Nagasaki Museum of History and Culture is one of the few museums in Japan dedicated to the history of International Exchange. The Museum holds an extensive collection of historical documents, art and craftworks that tell the story of Nagasaki, the sole window which was open to foreign countries during Japan's period of seclusion. In addition, part of the Nagasaki Magistrate's Office (a local agency of the central government in the Edo period) has been faithfully reconstructed based on historical materials, allowing visitors to immerse themselves in the atmosphere of feudal Japan. The exhibits are displayed to ensure an instructive and enjoyable experience.

Dejima Museum

Dejima was a Portuguese and subsequently a Dutch trading post at Nagasaki from 1634 to 1854.

It was also the location for trade with the Chinese at the time, and thus the only place designated for foreign trade and exchange during the historical Japanese Edo period. Dejima was a small fan shaped artificial island in the bay of Nagasaki covering an area of 120m x 75m (390ft x 250ft) and was built in 1634 to house Portuguese traders and separate them from Japanese society by digging a canal through a small peninsula. The Dutch were moved to Dejima in 1641 and during most of the Edo period the islands were the single place of direct trade between Japan and the outside world. In 1922, the "Dejima Dutch Trading Post" was designated a Japanese National Historic site.

Peace Memorial Park

On August 9, 1945, at 11.02am an atomic bomb exploded. The fierce blast wind, heat rays reaching several thousand degrees and deadly radiation generated by the explosion crushed burned and killed everything in sight and reduced the entire area to a barrel field of rubble. About one-third of Nagasaki City was destroyed. Peace Memorial Park is home to a beautiful memorial fountain, and statues donated from countries around the world leading to the 30-foot-high (9.7-metre-high) Statue of Peace.

Following your visit, commence the brief drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate to moderate amount of walking and standing for approximately 0.35 miles (about 600 meters) with about 20 steps at the visited sites and a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach. Jeju City, Folklore & Natural History Museum, Natural, Folkloric, Historical & Lifestyle Exhibits

Depart the pier for the short drive to the Jeju Folklore & Natural History Museum. Opened in 1984, the museum displays thousands of folkloric, natural, and historical artefacts excavated in Jeju-do. During your visit, explore the museum's four exhibition halls, which display a comprehensive and diverse array of historical, marine, natural, ecological, lifestyle, cultural, traditional, architectural, and dietary artefacts. An outdoor exhibition hall features diving gear utilised by 'haenyeo', or female divers, farming and traditional tools for daily living, ritual materials, and stone structures made from the volcanic rock of Jeju-do.

Halla Arboretum, Forest Trail, Greenhouse, Orchid Exhibition Hall, Bamboo Trail, Moss Garden

Next, re-board your coach and head to the Halla Arboretum. Upon arrival, take a quiet stroll through the tranquil forest of this serene environment. Highlights include a quaint greenhouse, which is home to rare plants endemic to Jeju Island. The colour contrast of green plants growing on black basalt leaves quite an impression, as does the captivating Orchid Exhibition Hall with its volcanic stones in every corner. At Jukrimwon, see different bamboo varieties densely planted along the wooden deck trail, creating a refreshing atmosphere with fresh air and the gentle warmth of summer. Finally, see the Ikkiwon (Moss Garden), which is covered almost entirely in different species of green moss.

Dongmun Market, Guided Tour, Free Time, Shopping

Leaving the Halla Arboretum, re-board your coach and drive to the Dongmun Traditional Market, which was established after the liberation in 1945. Due to a huge fire that broke out in March 1954, the entire market and nearby area were reduced to ashes. The market was then moved to its current location and kept its original name. As one of the most popular traditional markets in Jeju, Dongmun has served countless customers, selling a wide array of items at inexpensive prices. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of this bustling market, followed by some free time to browse for souvenirs. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the short drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking for approximately 2.7 miles (about 4.3 kilometres), at times over uneven and natural surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and 10-20 steps at the sites visited; a lift is available at the Jeju Folklore & Natural History Museum. Walking at the Dongmun Market is at the discretion of each guest. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Explore the spectacular natural wonders of South Korea during this scenic and invigorating, half-day hiking excursion. Jeju, Manjanggul Cave & Lava Tube, Guided Hiking Trek

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 45-minute morning drive to the Manjanggul Cave, one of the longest and finest lava tunnels in South Korea and the world, a Natural Monument, and an UNESCO World Heritage Site. A lava tunnel is formed when the lava that was deep in the ground spouts from the peak and flows to the surface. Formed about 300,000 to 200,000 years ago, the lava tunnel at the Manjanggul Cave measures approximately 75 feet (about 23 metres) wide and approximately 98 feet (about 30 metres) in height, and stretches for approximately 29,291 feet (about 8,928 metres). Upon arrival, proceed on-foot to the second of the cave's three entrances for a guided walking tour.

Stalactites, Stalagmites, Lava Formations, World's Largest Lava Column, Bat Species

Whilst walking through this captivating cave and a portion of a lava tunnel, see extremely well-preserved stalactites and stalagmites, along with lava columns, flowstones, helictites, blisters, rafts, bridges, shelves, and striations. Other highlights of your visit include the largest-known lava column in the world, a stunning lava column measuring approximately 25 feet (about 7.6 metres) in height, and the largest colony of common, bent-wing bats in South Korea. The tunnel's interior sustains a temperature of approximately 52 degrees Fahrenheit-70 degrees Fahrenheit (about 11 degrees Celsius-21 degrees Celsius), creating a comfortable climate for your walking tour.

Sunrise Peak, Volcanic Crater, Sharp Rocks, Cliffs, Crater Visit, Magnificent Sea & Coastal Views

Next, take a guided hike to the Seongsan Ilchulbong (Sunrise Peak), an UNESCO World Heritage Site. At its top is a huge volcanic crater measuring approximately 1,968 feet (about 600 metres) in diameter, and approximately 295 feet (about 90 metres) in height. With 99 sharp rocks surrounding the crater, it looks like a gigantic crown. The southeast and north sides are cliffs, northwest side is a verdant grassy hill connected to the Sunrise Village, and yellow fields of canola flowers surround the peak in spring. A hike up to the crater offers magnificent island and sea views. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately one-hour drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking for approximately 1.86 miles (about three kilometres), at times over uneven, rocky, slippery, and natural surfaces and inclines, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach, and 900 steps to enter the Mangjanggul Lava Tube and ascend the Sunrise Peak. This tour is recommended for active guests in good physical condition. This tour is not suitable for pregnant guests, guests with back and/or neck problems, guests with heart and/or respiratory conditions, guests with a fear of heights, guests with claustrophobia, guests with limited mobility, and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing or sportswear with flat, non-slip, and closed-toe walking or hiking shoes, and bring sun protection, insect repellent, a sweater or light jacket, bottled water, and local currency or credit cards for purchases from the ship. Guests must be at least eight years old to participate on this tour; minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian over 18 years old. Although frequently encountered on this type of tour, wildlife sightings are not guaranteed. Operation of this tour is subject to weather conditions. Experience the splendid native faces of Jeju Island during this picturesque, half-day sightseeing excursion. Jeju, Sangumburi Crater

Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately 40-minute drive to the south-east side of Jeju for a visit to Sangumburi, a massive volcanic crater designated as a Natural Monument. This enormous crater has a circumference of over 1.2 miles (about two kilometres), is approximately 710 yards (about 650 metres) in width, and approximately 109 yards (about 100 metres) in depth. From up above, the Sangumburi Crater looks like a man-made circular stadium.

Guided Crater Hike, Diverse Plant & Tree Species

Upon arrival, take a guided hike to the crater, where an incredibly vast and dazzling array of diverse plant and tree life awaits your arrival. On the north side, see Nandaeseong vegetation such as red-thorn and magnolia trees grow, along with rare winter strawberries. On the south side of the crater, Ondaerim vegetation such as evergreens, maples, and mountain strawberry trees blanket the area. Because so many different species of trees and plants grow in such a limited space, the Sangumburi Crater attracts the attention of researchers as well. Following your visit, re-board your coach and head to Jocheon-eup for a visit to the Jeju Stone Cultural Park.

Jeju Stone Cultural Park, Museum & Park Tours, Stone Objects, Art & Guardians

Upon arrival, take a guided walking tour of this captivating museum and ecological park. Inspired by Jeju's deeply-ingrained stone culture and applications of stones, the main theme focuses on the foundation and identity of Jeju Island, based on the myth of Seolmundae Halmang (Grandmother Seolmundae), who created Jeju Island and the Stones of Obaek Janggun (Five-Hundred Generals). The museum and park serve as historical and cultural spaces, where Jeju's foundation and culture are represented by a diverse collection of stone objects and guardians. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately one-hour drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking for approximately 1.86 miles (about three kilometres), at times over uneven, cobblestone, and natural surfaces and inclines, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and 10-20 steps to enter the buildings. Depart the pier for the scenic, approximately one-hour drive to the Hwansang Forest. One of four major areas of Gotjawal, this natural, green primeval forest in Jeju Island was formed on top of a rock. Upon arrival, take a guided and narrated walking tour through the forest, and listen to stories about the local lifestyle and people. In addition, learn about Gotjawal's diverse and abundant species of fauna and flora, which cohabitate on this prized area of unusual geography left behind by lava. Since it remains cool in the summer and warm in the winter, Gotjawal is the only place in the world where northern distributional limit plants and southern distribution limit plants can coexist.

Gotjawal Forest, Damyang, Foot Bath Venue, Oriental Herb Tea, Foot Bath

Next, re-board your coach and head to a nearby foot spa venue in Damyang, located in the Gotjawal Forest. KEE-A / Introduction to Taipei

Difficulty

This half-day tour provides an overview of some of Taipei's major attractions. There is great pride in what has been developed in Taiwan's capital in only 50 years - the result being truly remarkable.

Departing from Keelung port, travel on the freeway to bustling Taipei. Heading toward the National Taiwan Democracy Memorial Hall, also known as C.K.S. Memorial Hall, your drive takes you into the heart of the city and your first stop.

C.K.S. Memorial Hall

The majestic marble monument was built in honour of 'Generalissimo' Chiang Kai-Shek and to house the gigantic bronze statue of Taiwan's first president. The gleaming white building features an octagonal roof covered with blue glazed tiles and an 89-step staircase on two sides to the upper level. The enormous ground floor hall contains a museum with exhibits about Chiang's life, plus various tourist facilities and an elevator to the upper level.

Presidential Square

Following your visit, continue with your sightseeing drive, making a brief photo at the Presidential Square. Looming over the square is the impressive Office of the President, once the headquarters of the Japanese colonial administration in Taiwan. Partially destroyed by Allied bombs, the Nationalist government repaired the damages after the Japanese surrender. In 1998, the building was declared a historic national monument.

Martyrs' Shrine

Proceed with your drive, heading toward the grand and magnificent memorial known as Martyr's Shrine. Built in 1969 to honour the fallen heroes of China's wars, the monument is an excellent example of classical Ming dynasty architecture. Standing within an enormous park, the Martyr's Shrine enjoys a serene setting against a backdrop of the Chingshan Mountain. Take a walk through the extensive grounds and, if in luck, you may be able to observe the Changing of the Guard (subject to timing and weather).

Re-join your coach and conclude your Taipei overview with the drive back to Keelung port.

Please note: To visit all of the sites, an extensive amount of walking is required from the mandatory coach drop-off location. At the Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall, an elevator is available to the upper level. The tour sequence may vary. The drive to Taipei takes approximately 45 minutes in each direction. Space on this tour is limited.

KEE-B / Confucius Temple & Old Market Street

Experience various aspects of Chinese culture - the ornate Confucius Temple and the exotic Di Hua Market Street. Upon arrival in Taipei, your first visit is to the Confucius and Pao An Temples.

Confucius Temple

Temples to Confucius are a concrete symbol of Chinese Confucian culture. The origins of this stunningly beautiful temple complex can be traced back to 1875 when the Qing court established Taipei as a prefecture city for Northern Taiwan. The complex includes the literary and martial temples. Of special note are constructions on the roof of the main hall that look like chimneys.

Following your visit, a short drive brings you to the lively action of the Di Hua Old Market area.

Di Hua Old Market Street

Leave the coach for a leisurely stroll, taking in the sights and getting a feel of Taipei's past and present. The shops in the traditional Di Hua Market have been the most important place for Chinese medicine and exotic food items since the Japanese colonial period. While the market is most popular prior to the Chinese New Year, you may experience an atmosphere slightly less hectic.

At the end of your walk, re-join your coach for the drive back to Keelung Port. Time permitting, a photo stop at Taipei 101 for an exterior visit may be offered.

Please note: This tour involves some walking at the temples and the Di Hua Old Market Street, with a few steps to climb. Guests must be able to embark/disembark the coach via steps. Space on this tour is limited.

KEE-C / The Best of Taipei Capital City

Explore Taipei's most renowned attractions at a leisurely pace during this full-day orientation tour of the city, with buffet lunch at the landmark Grand Hotel or similar.

Depart the pier for 28-mile (45-kilometre) drive to Taipei City. Your tour commences with a visit to Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Park, which is dominated by the C.K.S. Memorial Hall, and flanked by the National Concert Hall and National Theatre.

C.K.S. Memorial Hall

Renamed the National Taiwan Democracy Memorial Hall, this white marble monument was built in honour of 'Generalissimo' Chiang Kai-shek to house the gigantic bronze statue of Taiwan's first president. The roof of this white marble structure is decorated with deep blue glass tiles, and the surrounding gardens have beautiful flowers year-round. An 89-step staircase on two sides leads to the upper level. The enormous ground floor hall features a museum where you can view exhibits showcasing Chiang's life.

Martyrs' Shrine

Next, your drive proceeds to the Martyrs' Shrine. Built in 1969 to honour the fallen heroes of China's wars, this grand and magnificent monument is an excellent example of classical Ming Dynasty architecture. Situated within an enormous park, the Martyrs' Shrine offers a serene setting against a backdrop of the Chingshan Mountain. During your stop, you may be able to observe the changing of the guard (time- and weather-permitting). Leaving the Martyrs' Shrine, continue on to the National Palace Museum.

National Palace Museum

The National Palace Museum is proud evidence that despite Taiwan's emergence as a political entity, at its heart is a Chinese culture thousands of years old. The museum's antique collection comprises some 700,000 pieces, spans almost all of China's entire 5,000-year history and is the world's largest and most priceless treasure house of Chinese art. Many of the objects were part of the Imperial collection, and date from the Sung Dynasty. Exhibits include porcelain, bronze, jade, sculptures, embroidery, calligraphy, paintings, and pottery. The sheer number of displays is overwhelming, and one visit can only provide a glance at this incredible and famous collection.

Lunch at Grand Hotel or similar

Your next stop is the famous Grand Hotel, host to numerous dignitaries since its opening in 1952. With its traditional Palacestyle architecture, vermillion pillars, brilliantly-tiled roof and palatial lobby, the Grand Hotel is not only a magnificent Taiwanese landmark, but emblematic of ancient China as well. After a buffet lunch at the hotel's Grand Garden restaurant or similar, your sightseeing tour continues with a visit to one of Taipei's most important temples.

Confucius Temple

Temples to Confucius are a concrete symbol of Chinese Confucian culture. Whilst the oldest of these temples in Shantung dates back 2,000 years, the origins of the Taipei temple can be traced to 1875, when the Qing court established Taipei as a prefecture for Northern Taiwan. During your visit, admire the ornate decorations and learn some facts about the various images.

Leaving the temple, a brief photo stop is made at the Presidential Square's impressive Presidential Office Building before arriving at your final stop, Taipei 101.

Taipei 101

Your visit to Taipei would not be complete without stop for photos and a look at Taipei's most modern architectural accomplishment. This uniquely-designed, 1,666.67-feet-high (508-metre) structure features 101 floors, and is one of the world's tallest buildings. It boasts a high-class, fashionable mall, an incredibly speedy elevator that takes only 37 seconds to reach the Observation Deck on the 89th floor and a food market that rivals the one at Harrods in London. Time permitting, explore the tower or browse the shops.

Afterwards, re-board your coach for the return drive to Keelung Port.

Please note: To visit all of the sites, an extensive amount of walking from the mandatory coach drop-off point is required. At the C.K.S. Memorial Hall there are 89 steps; an elevator is available if needed. Tour does not include a visit to the Observation Deck of Taipei 101 which may be visited independently, time permitting, for a fee, payable in local currency. Large bags are not permitted on the Observation Deck. A visit to Taipei 101 may not possible. The tour sequence may vary. The drive from the pier to Taipei is approximately 45 minutes in each direction.

KEE-D / Lungshan Temple & C.K.S. Memorial Hall

The West end of Taipei was once the center of political and economic activities of the city and where modern development started. This tour takes you through Taiwanese history, looking from the traditional beliefs of the late Qing dynasty, to the cultural shifts under Japanese ruling, then to the political landscape after the arrival of the Nationalist government in 1949.

Lungshan Temple

Lungshan Temple was founded in 1738 and dedicated to the Buddhist Goddess of Mercy (Kuan-in in Chinese, or Avalokitesvara in Sanskrit). Its architecture is a three-section design in shape. There are the front hall, the rear hall and the right/left dragons protecting the middle hall. The layout is square and serene. Due to natural disaster and damages caused by men, the temple was restored several times. The doors, beams, and poles are beautifully decorated. There is a pair of bronze dragon poles in the front hall, four pairs of dragon poles in the middle hall. The sculptures are delicate. There are also exquisite wood sculptures. Among them, the well and Budda setting in the main hall are highly appreciated. The temple has many Chinese poems, verses and lyrics on signs. These add a touch of literature in addition to the religious and sightseeing value.

Bopiliao Historical Block

At its peak during the late Qing Dynasty period (late 1800s), Bopiliao was one of the busiest and most prosperous commercial areas in Taipei, home to various merchants and was one of the major areas for the coal trade. During the Japanese occupation (1895-1945), new urban planning relegated the thoroughfare to a back alley as new roads were constructed to connect various parts of the city together in a more cohesive manner. This new connectivity within the city diminished the relevance of the area and it fell into disrepair.

The architecture of the area encompasses many different styles as Taiwan was passed from one colonial power to the next, including Southern Fujianese, Chinese Qing Dynasty, Japanese, ROC brutalist architecture influences, and modern Western architectural influences.

At the end of the cruise, re-board your coach for the ride to the Stanley Market viaRepulse Bay and Deep Water Bay.

Stanley Market

Once a fishing village, Stanley Market has earned a reputation as a paradise for bargain hunters as well as for its interesting scenery. The narrow lanes are lined with small shops offering a good selection of souvenir items. During your visit, you can stroll around the market and perhaps make a few purchases. Serious shoppers will want to return and explore the market at their leisure.

Leaving Stanley Market, your tour concludes with a brief drive back to the port.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking, with some stairs to climb and guests must be able to embark and disembark the coach and boat via steps. This tour is not suitable for guests who utilise a wheelchair. Comfortable shoes are recommended. Order of sights may vary. Bring local currency for any purchases.

HKG-B / The New Territories - Heritage & Tradition

Explore Hong Kong's ancient past during this picturesque, half-day journey to the villages, temples and ancestral homes located outside the city.

Depart the pier for the scenic drive out of the city and beyond the hills of Kowloon to a landscape dotted with ancient villages and historical sites. Highlights of your tour include visits to some of the area's most notable landmarks.

Man Mo Temple

Located on Fu Shin Street, the temple was built in 1892 with no windows. Part of the complex served as a market storehouse and town hall, whilst still providing a place for worshippers to this day.

Tang Chung Ling Ancestral Hall

Originally constructed in 1570 and rebuilt in the 18th century, this superb building is also a Historical Monument. The hall's elegant style and splendid décor include exquisite woodcarvings, mouldings and murals of auspicious motifs that reflect the superb craftsmanship of ancient times.

A remnant of more opulent days, **TSANG TAI UK** literally translates into 'Mr Tsang's Big House'. More accurately described as a walled village, it was a Tsang clan strong-hold built in the mid-19th Century. The architecture is typical of Hakka Chinese settlements in Guangdong (Canton) Province.

This interesting outing concludes with a brief drive back to the port.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Flat, comfortable walking shoes are recommended. Due to site closings, this tour is not available on Tuesdays. Due to road conditions, the tour operates in 23-seat mini-coaches. The order for sights may vary.

HKG-D / Hong Kong Old & New On Foot

Western District Walking Tour

Depart the pier for the approximately 30-minute drive to the Western District. Upon arrival, take a guided stroll along streets filled with seafood vendors and Chinese herb shops, two old traditions practised to this day. From here, pass by speciality shops selling ginseng and bird's nest on Wing Lok Street, and abalone, scallops and other exotic dried seafood items on Des Voeux Road West. See an abundance of herbal medicines along Ko Shing Street, and antique and curio shops on Hollywood Road.

Man Mo Temple & Staunton Street

Your tour continues with a visit to the Man Mo Temple, the oldest of its kind in Hong Kong. Afterward, ride the longest outdoor escalator past the Soho area before reaching Staunton Street. A stop is made at a Hong Kong-style café, a favourite local hangout. Unwind with a cup of local English tea or coffee accompanied by a famous egg custard tart - a Hong Kong experience.

Star Ferry

Next, continue to Central District, the bustling financial heart of the city filled with modern buildings. Upon arrival, embark the Star Ferry for a panoramic ride across Victoria Harbour and take in splendid views of the beautiful skyline, before returning to the pier.

High Tea at the Peninsula Hotel

Following your flight-seeing tour, proceed to the lobby of the *Peninsula Hotel*. The classical grandeur of the lobby epitomises all that is great about this legendary hotel. The lobby is a busy but relaxed all-day drinking and dining venue, and one of Hong Kong's premiere meeting-places. Afternoon High Tea at the *Peninsula Hotel* is a must during any Hong Kong visit, and is accompanied by a live string band.

Your tour concludes with a brief transfer back to the pier.

Embark on a scenic cruise of Aberdeen harbour to Lamma Island, on this full-day relaxing tour, with a seafood lunch at an open-air restaurant.

Transfer to Aberdeen in the late morning where your Chinese-style junk (boat) awaits. Cruise slowly through Aberdeen Harbour, viewing fascinating scenes that make up everyday life in this bustling, floating community.

Leaving the harbour, head out across the East Lamma Channel for the short journey to Sok Kwu Wan on Lamma's east coast. Lamma is, in contrast to Hong Kong Island and Kowloon, peaceful and tranquil, with relatively natural scenery. Buildings higher than three storeys are prohibited and there are no automobiles but diminutive fire trucks and ambulances, as well as distinctive open-back vehicles to transport construction materials. The community's only transport means is by foot or bicycle.

Dock in Sok Kwu Wan and walk to the open-air restaurant, where a seafood lunch is served. Enjoy traditional dishes with a soft drink or local beer.

Afterwards, there is time for an exploratory stroll at your leisure before re-boarding your junk for the journey back to Hong Kong Island. Passing the south end of Ap Lei Chau, your cruise continues via Deepwater and Repulse Bay, home to many of Hong Kong's tycoons and their opulent houses. Rounding the Chum Hom Kok headland, arrive at your destination, Stanley.

Upon disembarking the junk, board the transfer coach for the hour's ride back to the pier. If you wish, meander through Stanley's famous markets before making your own way back to pier by local taxi.

Victoria Peak

Also named Tai Ping Shan, or 'Mountain of Great Peace', Victoria Peak is visited by millions of tourists and locals every year, mainly for the breath-taking panoramic views of the city and harbour, but also because of the numerous interesting walks that begin here. After your photo stop, re-board your coach and head to the Tin Hau Temple.

Tin Hau Temple

Tin Hau, which means 'Goddess of the Sea', is revered by fishermen and anyone whose life and destiny is tied to the sea. Temples that honour her are found in abundance in Chinese coastal communities throughout Asia, and Hong Kong is no exception. The location of this particular temple in the middle of an urban area might strike you as rather odd, but you can learn why during a guided walking tour. Leaving the Tin Hau Temple, proceed on-foot to the nearby Wet Food Market.

Wet Food Market and Jade Market

These markets are windows into a vivid and timeless world of food shopping that refuses to be extinguished by modern supermarkets. Of all the wet markets in the city, this one abounds with bustling stalls selling fresh fruit, vegetables, meat and seafood. During your visit, experience the sights and sounds of this lively, old-school market in full swing. Afterward, continue on-foot to the renowned Jade Market. Here, hawkers sell various shapes and qualities of this precious stone. To the Chinese, jade has great spiritual value for warding off evil. When carved into certain shapes, it can represent wealth (deer), good fortune (tiger) and power (dragon). Guests are reminded not to purchase expensive jade unless accompanied by an expert. Following your visit, re-board your coach and commence the short drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 0.6 miles (about one kilometre), with a few high steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach. After lunch, board your coach and proceed to a local tea house. Upon arrival, view a tea-making demonstration and sample some tea. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the short drive back to the pier.

SGN-A / Saigon Discovery

This excursion provides an introduction to Ho Chi Minh City, formerly named Saigon, a vibrant and exciting city. Explore the highlights and have time to shop.

Departing the port, head toward Central Saigon to see or visit some of its many attractions.

History Museum

Start with a visit to this outstanding museum, considered the best place to get acquainted with Vietnam's history. Housed in a building from the early 1900s, the museum displays artefacts from the Bronze Age to the early communist presence in Vietnam. Other exhibits feature Cham art, ceramics, and traditional costumes.

Leaving the museum, the bus will take you to the Notre Dame Cathedral, distinguished by its imposing twin spires. Along the way, stop for photos at the splendid Reunification Palace and the elegant Saigon City Hall. Then, switching back to the coach, drive to China Town, known locally as Cholon.

Saigon Market

Visit the large market place in central Ho Chi Minh City Ben Thanh located in the Saigon Market. A short twenty minute stroll through Ben Thanh market offers a kaleidoscope of colours and a hive of activities.

Thien Hau Temple

Next, proceed to this beautiful temple built in 1825 and dedicated to the cult of Thien Hau, Goddess of the Sea and Protector of Sailors.

Lacquer Factory

The last visit is to one of Saigon's best known establishments for an introduction to the making of the city's renowned lacquer ware. Browse through the showrooms, where a fascinating array of items tempts even the most jaded shopper.

From here, the tour returns to the port. Time permitting and if you prefer, remain in town and make your own way back to the ship at your leisure.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking. It is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Dress in lightweight clothing and bring sun protection; anticipate hot and humid weather. Order of sites seen or visited may vary. Bring local currency for any purchases; US dollars and credit cards are accepted in many stores.

SGN-B / Saigon Street Food Experience

Depart the pier for the Food Street Market. Following a guided and narrated stroll around Saigon Food Street Market. After the visit, drive to the Tan Dinh Market.

Tan Dinh Market, Vendors and Food Stalls

Next, head to the large market place District 1 of Ho Chi Minh City, the Tan Dinh market, which is best-known for its down-home Vietnamese food. A number of vendors and food stalls in the market's food section offer dishes freshly-made to order.

Various local dishes can be purchased here, including Vietnamese pancakes (banh xeo), fresh spring rolls (goi cuon), hue cakes (banh beo) and Vietnamese noodle soup (pho).

Ngon Restaurant and Lunch

Leaving the Tan Dinh Market, re-board your coach and drive to the Ngon restaurant, which offers an extensive menu of foods gathered from northern to southern Vietnam. The concept behind the restaurant is to bring together many different street vendors under one roof. In this compact venue, a wide array of classic Vietnamese dishes from throughout the country are prepared with the flair, independence and simplicity of the impressive local street fare. A light Vietnamese lunch is served after exploring the food stalls. At the conclusion of your visit, re-board your coach and commence the approximately 30-minute drive back to the pier.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking for approximately 547 yards (about 500 metres), at times over uneven and cobblestone surfaces, with a few steps to negotiate to get on/off the coach and at the sites visited. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and guests who utilise a wheelchair. Lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes and sun protection are recommended.

SGN-C / Good Evening, Saigon

Experience an evening of traditional Vietnamese food and cultural entertainment as you bid Saigon a 'good evening'. Majestic Hotel

Begin with a transfer to the legendary Majestic Hotel, which, since 1925, has occupied one of the finest locations in Saigon, boasting stunning views of the Saigon River. After you are graciously welcomed by hostesses in traditional dresses, sip predinner cocktails on the hotel's terrace, with its sweeping view of central Saigon. Both the old world boutique charm of the hotel and the elegance of the columned and arched classical French-colonial design help create a special ambiance for your evening.

The Majestic has gone through several reincarnations over the years, changes that reflect the tumultuous history of Vietnam. During World War II, the Japanese Imperial Army used this French colonial structure as their military barracks. During the Vietnam War, it was frequented by foreign correspondents and espionage agents. Enjoy a special show featuring traditional music, dances, and costumes from the northern and southern regions of Vietnam.

Mandarin Restaurant

Following the entertainment, proceed to one of the finest Vietnamese restaurants in Saigon to savour a feast of local specialties. All too soon this special evening of Vietnamese culture and tradition comes to a close and your coach returns you to the ship.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate amount of walking, with steps to climb at the Majestic Hotel. The bar area is not wheelchair accessible. Dress in lightweight clothing; anticipate hot and humid weather. Order of sites seen or visited may vary. Although space is limited, a minimum number of guests is required to operate this tour. Should the ship be docked outside of the city, the tour duration will be a minimum of 30-60 minutes greater. Meal substitutions cannot be accommodated. We suggest our guests to not sign up at the evening tour if they are booked on the tour SGN-D Life in the Mekong Delta.

SGN-D / Life in the Mekong Delta

Mekong Delta

Depart the ship for the 2-hour journey along a well-paved road to the Mekong Delta area. The mighty Mekong River, originating in Tibet and flowing through several countries before its 120-mile (193-kilometre) course through Vietnam, divides

into nine river mouths, aptly called the Nine Dragon Delta by locals. This flourishing region is criss-crossed by numerous natural and man-made canals serving the local traffic.

My Tho & Mekong River

Following the drive on the highway your drive will take you through some villages and small towns to arrive at a branch of the Me KongRiver. Here, after a short comfort stop, board a local long boat for an interesting ride past the stilt houses along the riverbanks, giving you the rare chance to experience the Mekong for yourself.

Scenic Mekong River Cruising

The scene while sailing along the Mekong river offers some great photo opportunities. A stop will be made for a visit to a local farm village on Thoi Son island. Walk around the village and enjoy a refreshing cup of tea with your host. Continue sailing for a stop to a traditional workshop to learn about the typical daily activity then enjoy the sampan ride to access the maze of narrow waterways. Following your visit, proceed for a traditional Vietnamese lunch at the local restaurant.

After dining, visit to one of the oldest pagoda in Mekong Delta, Vinh Trang, before for the 2 hour journey back towards Ho Chi Minh City to rejoin ship.

Please note: This tour requires an extensive amount of walking. The tour is suitable for mobility challenge guests as long as they are able to embark/disembark the van and maneuver on and off the local boat with little assistance. Lightweight, comfortable clothing and rubber-soled shoes are recommended. Transportation is by van (6-8 pax per vehicle). Guests are advised to wear lightweight, comfortable clothing with flat, closed-toe walking shoes, and bring sun protection and bottled water. US dollars are accepted in the souvenir shops. The Vietnam War, or the American War as it is known in Vietnam, pitched modern American technology against fierce Vietcong resistance waging a guerrilla war. On this full-day tour, experience a local perspective on wartime memories and the infamous Cu Chi Tunnels.

The two and half hour drive southwest from Saigon to the Cu Chi Tunnels is a pleasant foray into the surrounding countryside. It is hard to believe you are entering a former war zone of such strategic importance. The busy road passes through tranquil rice paddies where entrepreneurial villagers use the hot roadside as a platform for drying all manner of produce. Hundreds of sheets of paper dot the countryside, drying on woven racks in the relentless sun. A short stop is made at a small village for photos of the countryside view and paddy fields.

At Cu Chi, your guide explains the underground network, shows the displays of tools and weapons used by the guerrillas, and provides insight into the ingenious methods that the Vietnamese soldiers employed to remain undetected. Work on the tunnels began in 1948 during the war against the French, and greatly expanded throughout the 1960s.

Measuring 31 inches (80 cm) wide and five feet (1.5 metres) tall, the maze of tunnels was extensive, extending over 120 miles (193 kilometres). They included storerooms, sleeping quarters, kitchens, medical facilities and classrooms, and at one time, over 16,000 people lived in the tunnels. Most only 2 or 2.5 feet wide by 5 feet high (60-72cm X1.5 metres), the tunnels had thick roofs capable of withstanding the weight of tanks or the impact of bombs weighing up to 200 pounds (91 kilograms). Some have been enlarged to accommodate visitors at the site.

Following your visit to the tunnels, board your coach for your return to the ship.

Please note: This tour requires a moderate to extensive amount of walking. It is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or those who utilise a wheelchair. Walking through the tunnels requires additional exertion. Guests participating on this portion of the tour should be fit and not prone to claustrophobia; guests may opt not to enter the tunnels. In the tunnels closest to the surface the actual rooms may be open to the sky above, with the tunnels in between fairly short. Approximately one hour is spent on site Cu Chi site. In Cu Chi guests will see sensitive material, including graphic pictures and displays of the

atrocities of war. Sturdy shoes, sun protection, and mosquito repellant are recommended. The duration of the drive between the pier and the tunnel are is approximately 2 hours in each direction.

Museum of Ho Chi Minh City

War Museum

Next, re-board your coach and continue on to the War Museum. During your guided visit, explore war relics and detailed exhibits, at times shocking, about the American war in Vietnam. The museum comprises a series of themed rooms in several areas, with period military equipment placed within a walled yard. This museum is currently the most popular museum in Ho Chi Minh City, it has welcomed half of million visitors each day.

At the conclusion of your visit, re-board you coach for approximately 45-60minutes drive back to the ship.

Next, re-board your coach and drive to Café Vot, the 'Racquet Café'. During your visit, observe how they brew their coffee in the traditional way for its unique and special taste, and enjoy their coffee on the sidewalk filled with tiny plastic stools. Your last

stop is at the Saigon Retro Concept Café. Located in a small valley, this eclectically-furnished café exudes a laid -back vibe and cool, retro feel. Following a cup of coffee here, drive to Pho, a local noodle shop for snack lunch with a noodle soup along with a cup of coffee. Coffee here is not just a drink, but a social aspect of life. Morning, noon and/or night, coffee is for people of all ages and classes, and a part of Saigon's history is brewed into every cup of coffee made here.

Following your Vietnamese -snack lunch, re -board your coach and commence the short drive back to the pier.

Singapore

On your short scenic tour, get to experience both history and modern Singapore with her magnificent views to take home memories of your visit to this city-state of Singapore. For the breadth, scope, and magnitude of its collections, the National Gallery Singapore is widely considered by art enthusiasts as being one of the greatest art museums in Singapore and the region. Subsequently, it is one of the most visited art museums in the world, often attracting almost two million visitors annually. The museum is composed of a combination of the Old Supreme Court Building and City Hall, both of which are national monuments and have played significant roles in Singapore's history.

National Gallery

Housed in the former Supreme Court, the UOB Southeast Asia Gallery presents the history of Southeast Asian art through artistic impulses shared across the region. The UOB Southeast Asia Gallery shares a compelling story of human culture, as seen through a region that has been the meeting point of major civilizations, religions, colonial powers, and the focus of struggles towards national independence and modernization. The Gallery explores four main themes critical to the art of this region: Authority and Anxiety, Imagining Country and Self, Manifesting the Nation and Redefining Art.

Raffles Landing Site, Riverboat Ride

The historical and cultural landmarks that line the city's riverfront are prominently visible from the 30-minute river cruise ride. A ride along the Singapore River in one of the colourful riverboats makes for a fun-filled experience. In Raffles' days, these vessels were used to transport goods.
